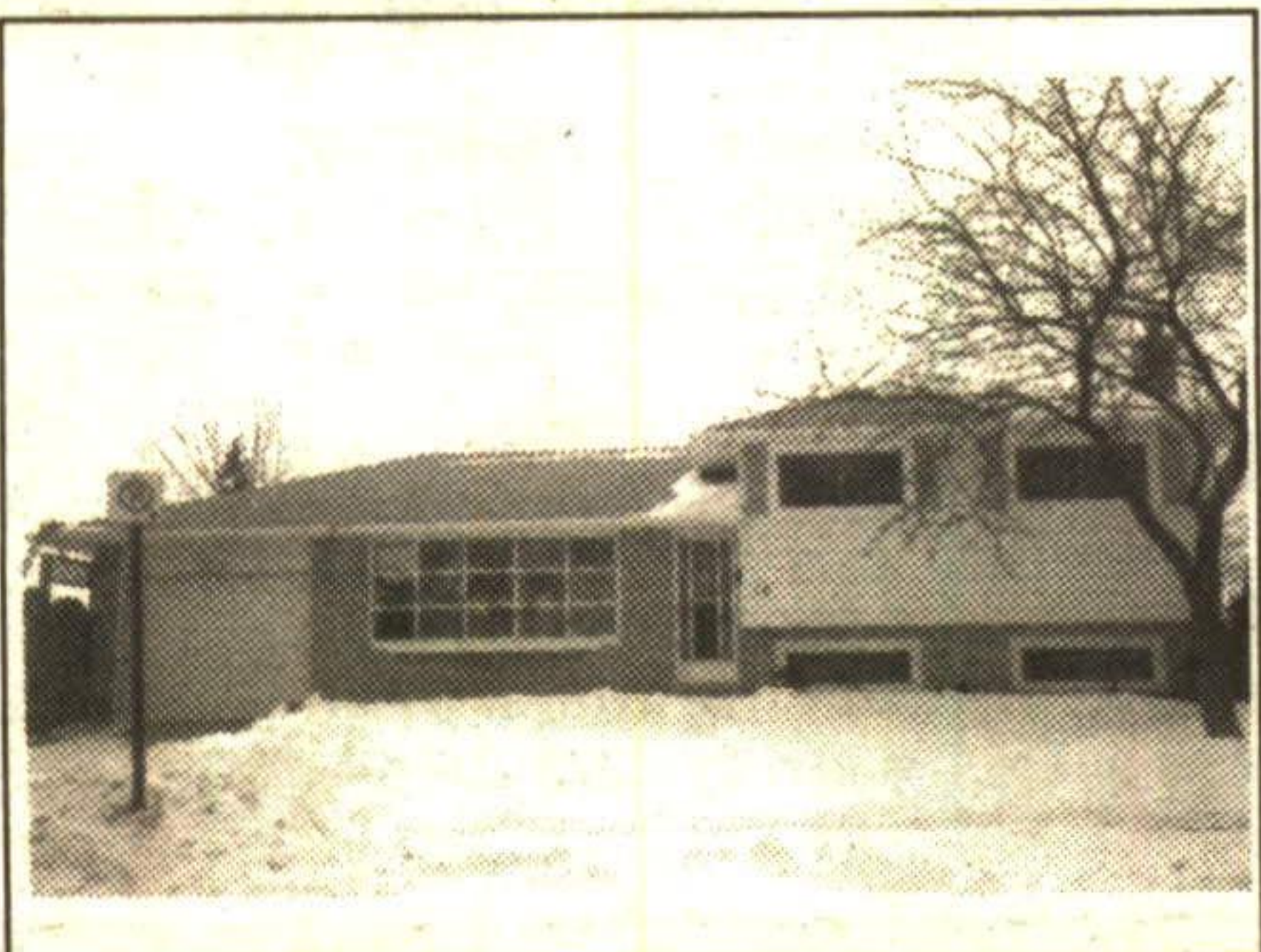

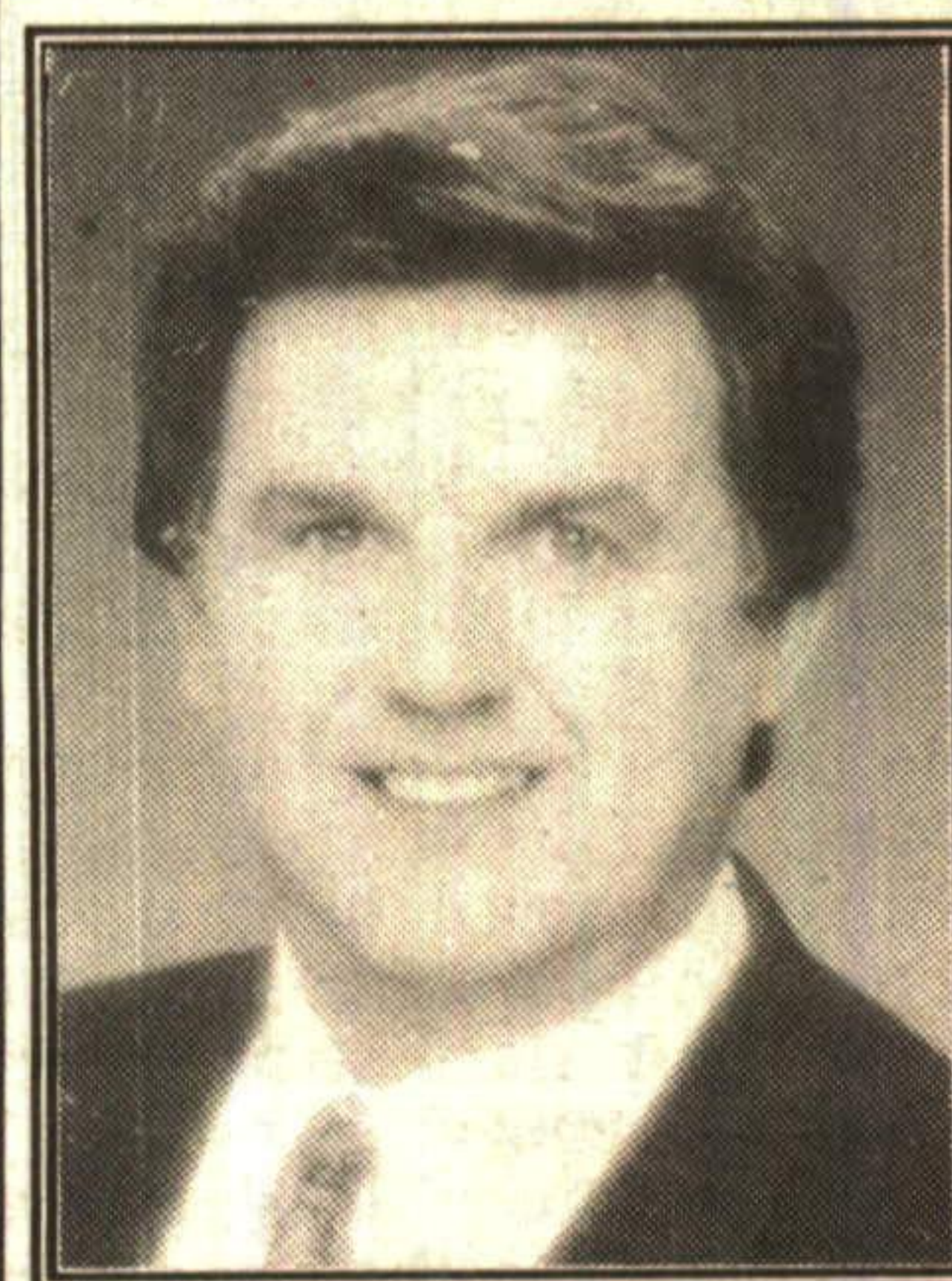

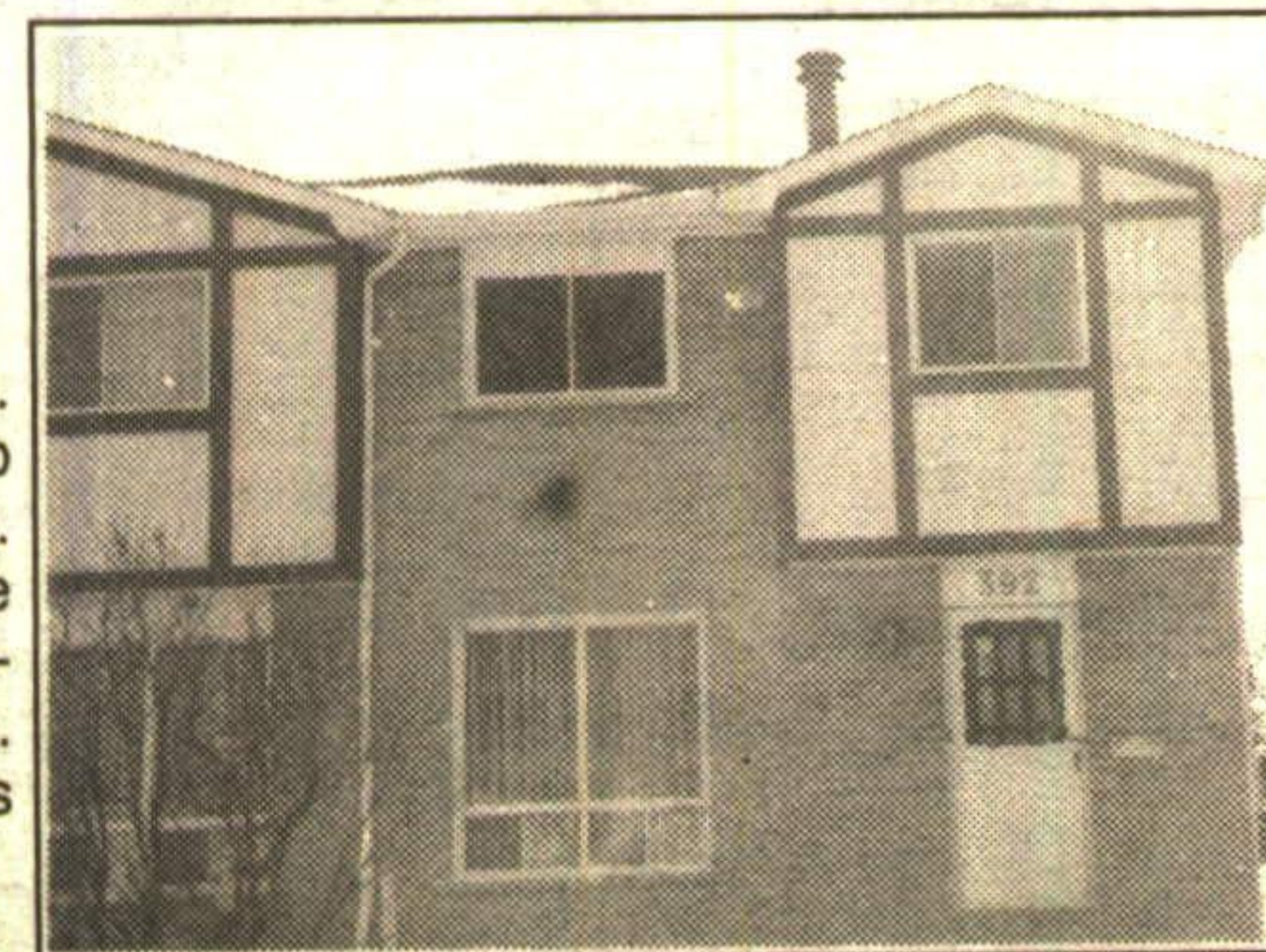

Crime Stoppers

Armed robber may have struck twice

Police think a robbery at a CIBC in Milton two weeks ago could be related to one in Acton last month, and Crime Stoppers would like to help solve them both.

On Friday, Feb. 11, just before 8 p.m., a man walked up to the tellers' counter in the branch at 147 Main St. He demanded cash while displaying a hand gun. The culprit left after receiving some money.

A car pulled out of the bank's parking lot immediately afterward, and investigators would like to interview the driver of that light colored sub-compact, which turned

east on Main St.

There are similarities in the description of the gunman with that of the Acton suspect. The man sought by police for the Milton hold-up was described as white, 5'9" or 5'10", slim, 30-40 years, wrinkles around light colored eyes, with reddish brown hair. He wore a black ski mask.

If you have any information that leads to an arrest in this or any other case, you may be eligible for a cash reward of up to \$1,000. You need not give your name and your information will be treated with complete anonymity.
