The recently announced proposed federal electoral boundaries will split the town of Halton Hills,

resulting in Acton residents being situated in Peel-Dufferin-Wellington electoral district, and Georgetown residents in Halton Centre.

Under the proposed revisions Halton Hills residents who live northwest of 15 Sideroad, east of Townline Rd., north of Wildwood Rd., Main St. and Prince St. in Glen Williams and north of the Credit River to the Halton Hills border will be in the Peel-Dufferin-Wellington district.

The Halton Centre riding will encompass all of Georgetown, Milton, most of north Oakville, north Burlington and all of Nassagewaya.

Currently all of Halton Hills is situated in the Halton-Peel district, which also includes parts Burlington, Caledon and Milton. The 1991 population of the district was 114,670.

At a cost of about \$7.6 million, electoral boundaries were evaluated across the country, as required by federal legislation. In Ontario the boundary changes are the

work of the Federal Electoral Boundaries Commission for Ontario. The goal of the commission was to redraw electoral districts in Ontario so their populations correspond to 97,912.

Under the proposed changes Halton-Peel MP Julian Reed is in the unusual position of having his home situated in the Peel-Dufferin**Boundaries Commission of Ontario.** 

"If we are going to be faced with that plan I will be mounting an appeal of the boundary realignment," said Reed. "With the split of Acton and Georgetown it is obvious

there was no consideration given to the continuity of community."

Due to expanding population in areas of the country the proposed revisions will result in six new MP seats, four in Ontario (Halton, Durham, York and Peel) and two in British Columbia.

Reed said that each MP costs the taxpayers about \$500,000 a year, when all expenses (salaries, staff, offices etc.) are considered.

"When we are in such horrific financial circumstances we shouldn't be adding any costs," said Reed.

The revised boundaries are not final and the public will have ample opportunity comment on them through public hearings on the proposal.






