NO. 10 SIDEROAD (REGIONAL ROAD #10)

The Regional Municipality of Halton in accordance with the provincially approved Class Environmental Assessment for Municipal Road Projects is undertaking a Preliminary Design Study for the reconstruction of approximately five kilometres of Regional Road 10 from Trafalgar Road to Winston Churchill Boulevard in the Town of Halton Hills.
