## Choral Society's future is singing

What is it that makes the Georgetown Choral Society so special?

It is the one thing that all of the members have in common: a love of singing.

The Georgetown Choral Society (GCS) is achieving higher and higher standards and expertise as each year brings a new challenge.

Part of the appeal of the GCS is the spirit of fun and fellowship which pervades the practices, concerts and social gatherings.

In 1990 the choir was invited by the Etton Mannekoor to tour with them in the Netherlands. This concert tour was to celebrate the Liberation of the Netherlands by the Canadian Forces in 1945.

In 1992, the Georgetown Choral Society returned the favor by inviting the Etton Mannekoor to join them and the Achill Choral Society for what turned out to be a sold-out performance at Roy Thompson Hall in Toronto.

Once again, the Etton Mannekoor has invited the GCS to sing with them to celebrate the 50 year anniversary of Liberation in 1995. The tour will

take the choirs through Holland.

The Georgetown Choral Society is becoming increasingly well known in the surrounding area. In the past several years their talents have been combined with the Achill Choral Society, the Oakville Orchestra, and the Toronto Youth Orchestra.

For the past two years the Georgetown Choral Society has performed Handel's Messiah in Georgetown and at Redeemer College in Ancaster with the Etobicoke String Orchestra and four guest soloists.

The repertoire of the choir ranges from Broadway musicals to classics such as Brahms's Requiem, the Messiah, Mass in A Major, Mozart's Requiem, Fantasia for Christmas, Vaughan Williams' Sea Symphony and many more.

The members of the GCS are getting busy with fundraising for their trip throughout England and Holland.

The choir invites anyone who enjoys singing to come out and join us. Practices are each Monday evening at 7:30 at the Knox Presbyterian Church in Georgetown.
