FRESH TOMATO AND **WILD MUSHROOM PIZZA**

(Servings: Four)

Dough Ingredients:

1/2 tablespoon dry activated yeast

cup warm water cups all purpose flour

teaspoon salt tablespoon olive oil

Topping Ingredients:

tomatoes

ounces mixed wild mushrooms

(i.e. portabello, cremini, shiitake)

tablespoon olive oil

ounces low fat mozzarella, grated tablespoons parmesan cheese, grated

teaspoons chopped fresh basil

freshly ground black pepper extra-virgin olive oil

For the Pizza Shells:

Dissolve yeast in warm water. In a mixer with a paddle attachment, combine dissolved yeast, one cup of the flour and salt. Add the olive oil and continue to mix for one minute, reduce speed and mix in the second cup of flour. Place dough in a bowl in a warm place and allow to rise until doubled in volume. Punch down dough and divide into four pieces. Roll each piece in a circular shape, brush with olive oil and allow to rise in a warm place for 15 minutes. Dough can be grilled, turning once, or baked in a 450° oven until light brown.

For the Topping:

Sauté the mushrooms in olive oil in a nonstick pan. Set aside to cool. Slice tomatoes 1/4" thick and divide tomatoes and mushrooms among the pizza shells. Drizzle a small amount of olive oil on top and season with the fresh pepper and basil. Top with cheeses and bake in a 450° oven 15-20 minutes or until cheese is melted and pizzas are hot.
