Georgetown District High School's first vice principal, Alexander McLaren Baxter, died at the

Georgetown and District Memorial Hospital Longterm Care Section on February 25, 1994 in his 87th year.

He was a graduate of the University of Manitoba, earning a B.Sc degree. He followed in the footsteps of his parents by joining the teaching profession. He taught in Fort Garry High School and other schools in Manitoba for eleven years before taking up a teaching appointment in Alton, Ontario. After spending two years in Alton, he came to Georgetown High School in

He taught Science and later became department head. In 1957 he was appointed as the first vice principal of the high school, under the principalship of Mr. Leonard Lambert.

Mr. Baxter had an excellent rapport with the teachers, students, parents and the community-at-large. Teachers remember him as a valued colleague and referred to him as "Mac", while the students fondly remember him as a friend, even if they had to come in at 8:00 a.m. for detentions.

The 1967 school yearbook called "The Challenge", was dedicated to Mr. Baxter. Principal Donald F. Turner wrote," The selection of Mr. Baxter as the person to whom you have dedicated this year's yearbook,

is your expression of your appreciation to a member of the staff who had dedicated many years of service to the students of this school."

He is survived by his two sons and their spouses, (Blake and Marilyn of Georgetown and Duncan and

gentleman who never neglected to share wise counsel, a smile, a grin or laughter, even under trying times. His life was one of dedication and service.




