



Supplements to Security

Seniors who receive a supplement to Old Age Security will have form entitled received a "Application for Renewal of Guaranteed Income Supplement or Spouses Allowance 1993/94".

Complete this application by March 31.

If it is not received in time for processing your April cheque will be cut back to the basic Old Age Security amount of \$385.51.

The amount will be re-adjusted when the application is received and any retro-active payments will be made, but for seniors receiving supplements, to have their cheque cut would be a hardship, even though temporary.

Wait for necessary papers - You must have the stubs from February's cheque of the Canada Pension Plan or other pension, and the bank statement of how much interest you have received.

All of this has to be declared so please wait until you have this information telling you exactly what you received in 1991.

The same amounts must be used in your Income Tax Return it will be noticed by Income Security and will result in an adjustment of your cheque later on.

What to include - When filling out the application do not declare your Old Age Supplements or Spouses Allowance received. You need only declare your "private"

income, which includes Canada Pension, Work's Pension, Insurance and Bank Interest etc.

If you have queries or are having difficulties completing this application, call Income Security toll-free at 1-800-265-9480 (from 519 area code) or 1-800-387-5280 (from 905 area code). These phone lines are often busy, be patient and call at 8 a.m., when office first opens.

If you have further problems or have tried completing the application and still having difficulties, the staff at Acton Social Services can give you some assistance.
