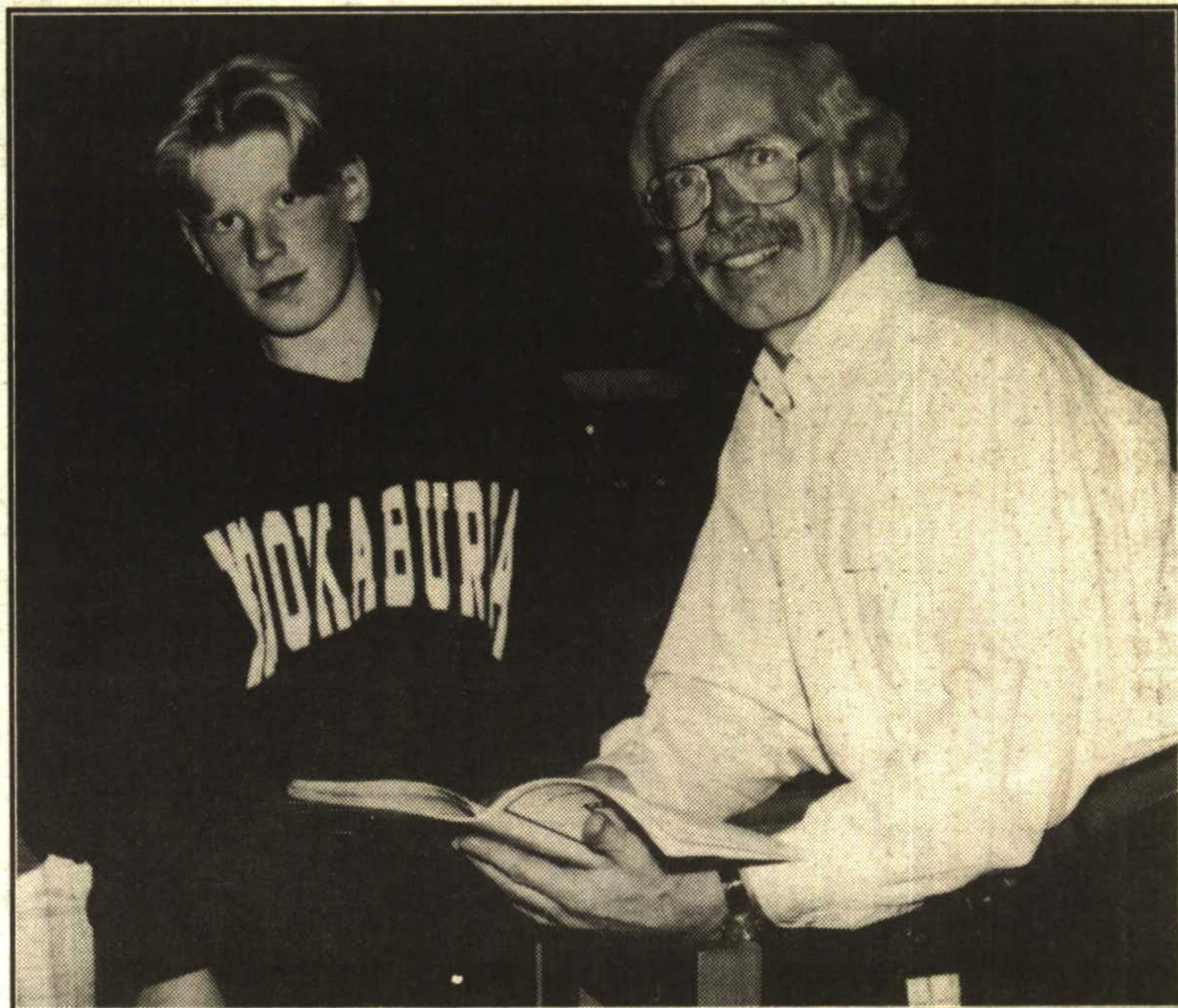
\$3.50.

Traditional rughooking is seen as many things to many people. It's a hobby, a craft, an artform and more often than not, all three.


The public is invited to view and enjoy the creative achievements of over 500 members. Each participating guild will have a representative on duty to answer questions.
