Call one of the following volunteer programs to learn a new skill, utilize existing skills or meet new people. Uncertain where to volunteer? Contact the Volunteer Centre at 878-0955 to discuss the variety of opportunities available.

• Do you have a keen interest in helping the environment? Wastewise can use your help as a Toy Aisle Maintenance Volunteer. On Fridays 9-10 a.m. tidy the toys and clear non-functional ones from the aisle.

If you enjoy tinkering with small appliances, a repair person is required to fix toasters, kettles, etc. for reuse or dismantle for scrap metal. Wednesday or Thursday evenings, 6-8 p.m.

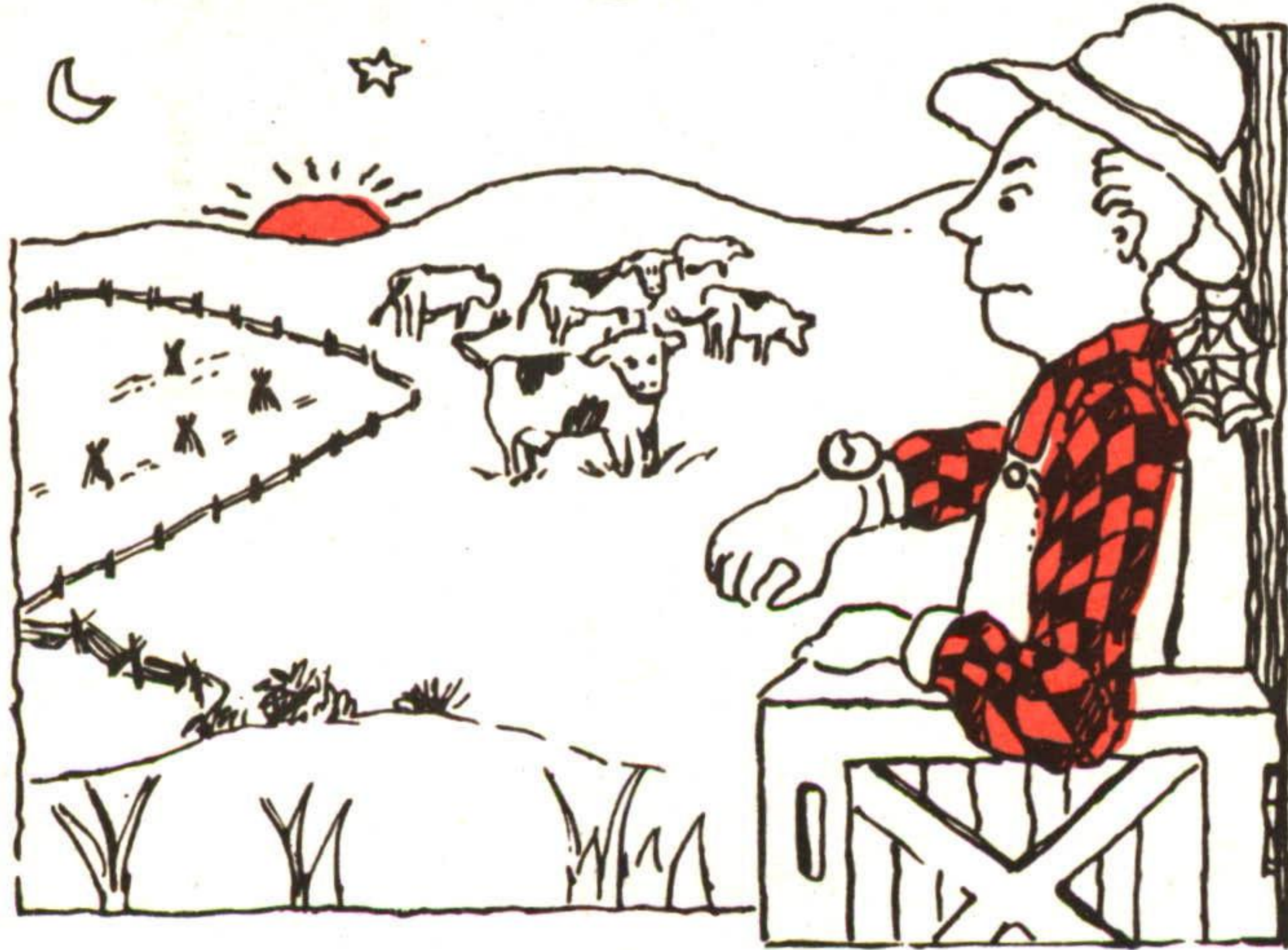

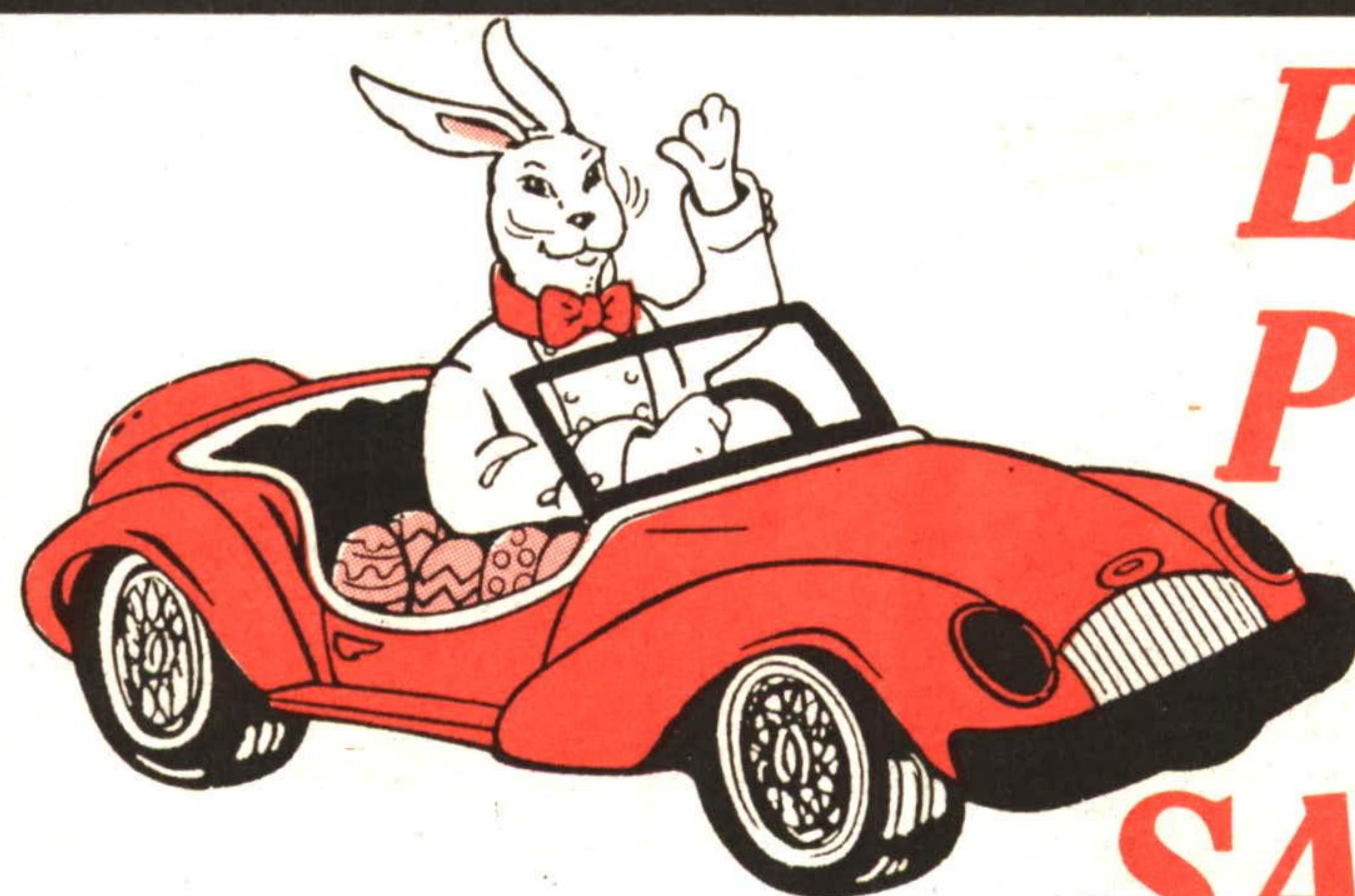
