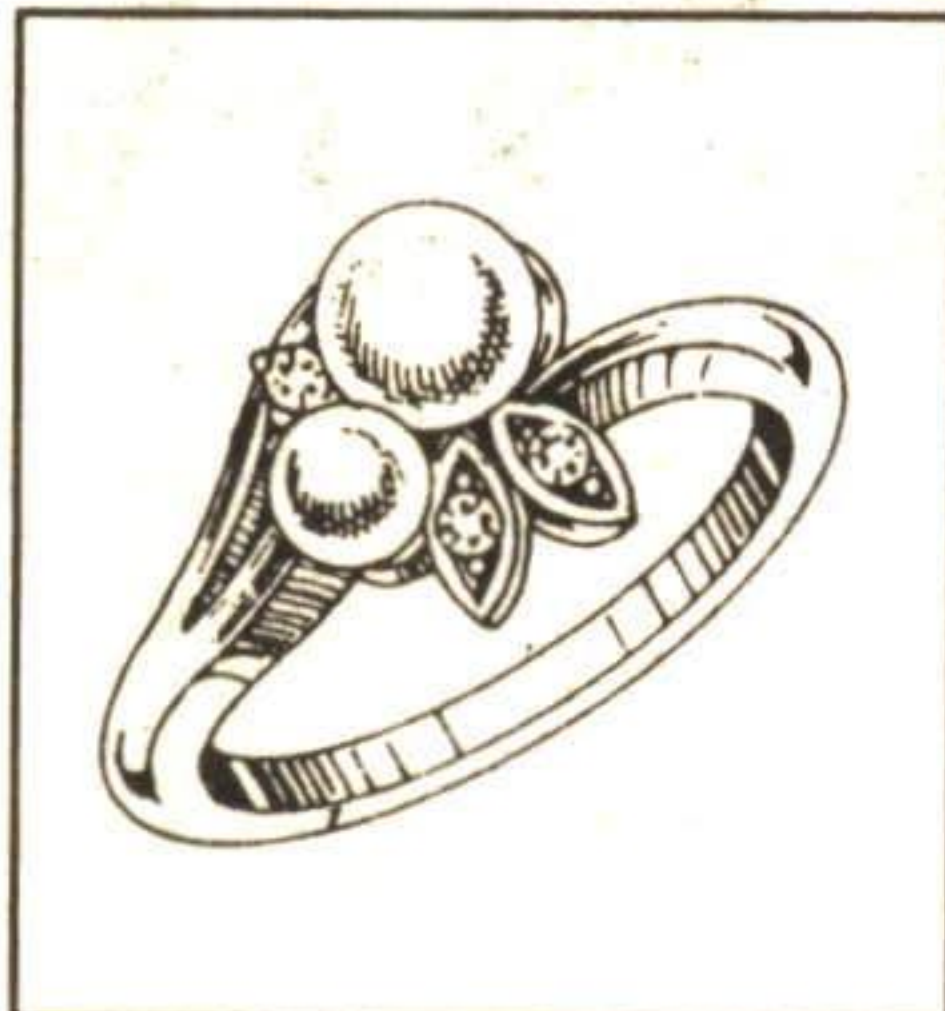
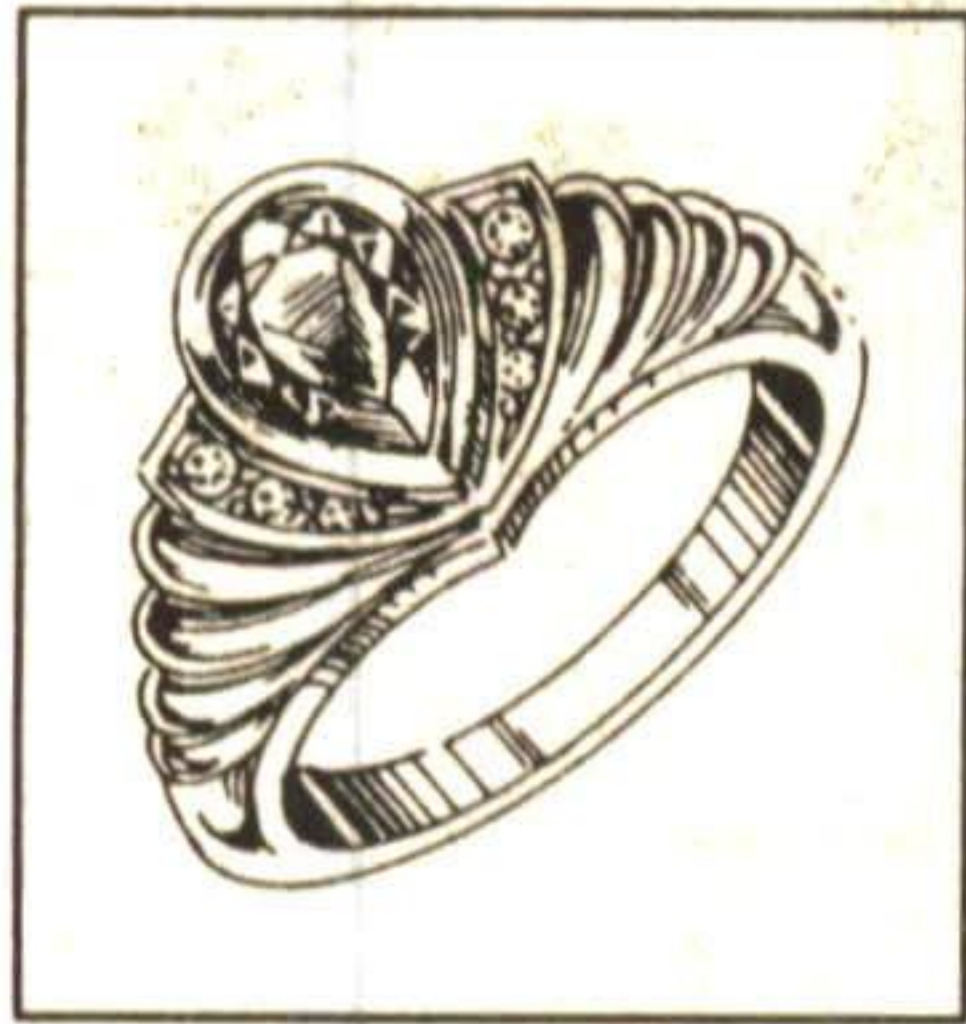
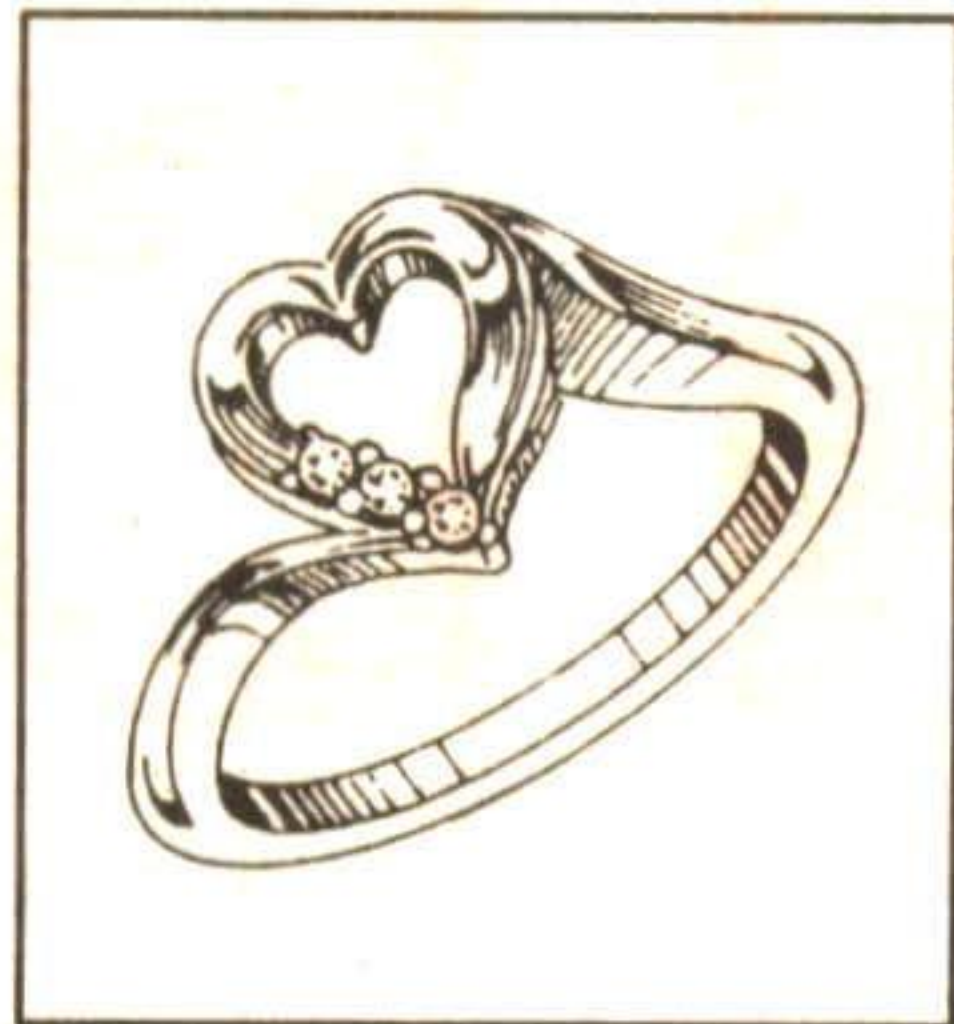

Funding request

A funding request for supportive housing for people living in the seniors buildings in Halton Hills has been accepted by the Ministry of Health.

But the ministry has put the onus for deciding which programs get funding into the hands of the Halton District Health Council (HDHC). The funding would bring more non-medical services, like homemaking, to help people stay in their own apartments longer.

The Ministry has sent a letter to HDHC saying that \$844,000 will go to Halton region for supportive housing over a multi-year period.

"My staff have reviewed the proposals in your area of which they are aware and would like to indicate our ministry's willingness to proceed with the Georgetown Hospital Wave One project. Your council indicated the strong support it has

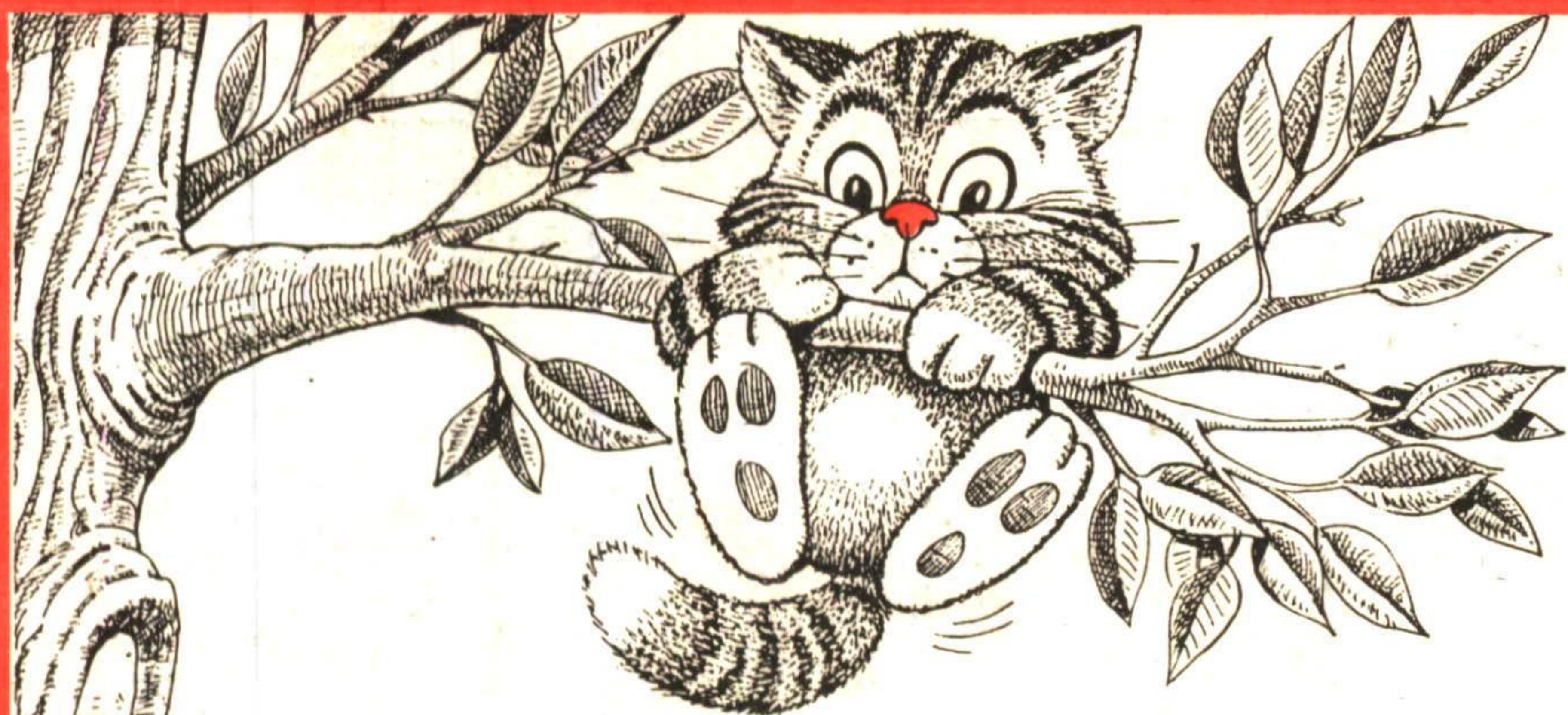
for this proposal earlier this year," the letter from Ruth Grier wrote.

"We hope the HDHC will follow the lead of the ministry and direct this money up here as soon as possible to bring the services here," said John Oliver, executive director of the hospital.

Jane Sanders, assistant executive director of the HDHC said that discussions of which proposals will get money will begin later this month.

"If we're really lucky, we might get the services in place by September, but it may even be longer than that," she said.

This request shouldn't be confused with the hospital's plans to put a new supportive housing development on the hospital grounds. The hospital has been waiting for several months to find out if this will get the green light. The Ministry of Housing has been asked to provide funding for this, through the jobsOntario program.

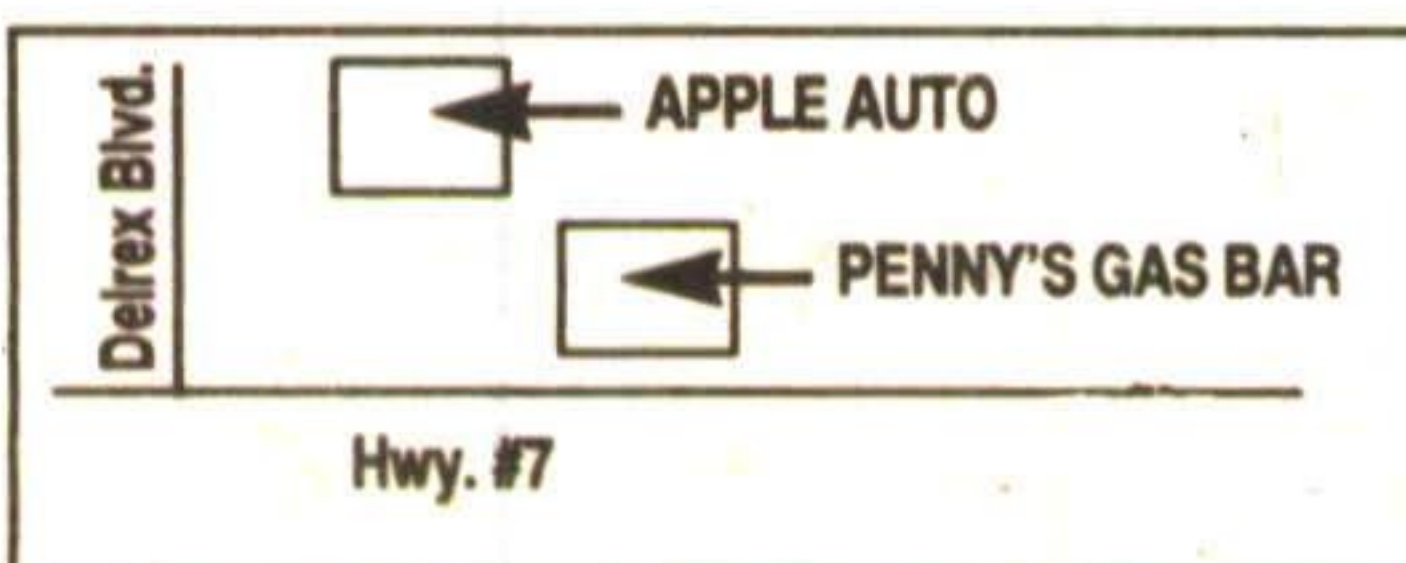
