For Nineveh's Sake!, a musical by Walter Farquharson and Ron Klusmeier based on the Old Testament story of Jonah, is touring Canada in 1994 and comes to Georgetown on Wednesday, May 25.

The 7:30 p.m. performance will be at St. John's United Church. It is one of nearly 200 which are scheduled for the ambitious national tour.

The play is written by Rev. Walter Farquharson and Ron Klusmeier.

The Very Rev. Dr. Walter H. Farguharson is a minister with the United Church of Canada, a pastor of three congregations in

Saskatchewan. Farquaharson has served the national church on many committees and is the immediate past moderator of the United Church. He is well known for his hymn texts and has had his work included in dozens of hymnbooks and publications.

Ron Klusmeier is a musiciancomposer whose hymns and songs are included in over 90 hymnbooks and publications throughout the world. He has worked closely with Farquaharson and other contemporary hymn text writers to create new hymns and songs for worship. Klusmeier has composed over 600

selections and Farquaharson is his closest writing partner. Together, they have also created a Christmas Cantata (God's Gentle Gift) and an Easter Cantata (Didn't Our Hearts Burn Within Us?). Klusmeier has more of his original compositions included in Songs for a Gospel People (the United Church's supplementary hymnbook) than any other contributor.

One of the dreams that shared Farquharson Klusmeier was his idea to create a musical based on the Old Testament story of Jonah. Farguharson had written the opening poem/selection

(There's a Job to be Done) and the rest was just an idea. Klusmeier set the poem to music on the spot and For Nineveh's Sake! had its birth.

In 1992, a commitment to produce For Nineveh's Sake! for a 1994 national tour was made. After over a decade of dormancy, Jonah has been re-worked, updated, and cast into a performing troupe which will take the production to nearly every corner of Canada for six months in

Cast and crew members is made up of 14 (mostly!) young people from communities throughout Ontario and Manitoba. They came

together for the first time on 8 December 1, 1993 and rehearsed until Christmas. Their first performance was January 4, when the ambitious schedule of 5 to 9 presen- ≥ tations per week was begun.

The touring schedule includes performances throughout Ontario, Manitoba, Saskatchewan, Alberta, and British Columbia, Quebec, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Prince Edward Island and Newfoundland.




