Scholarship fund set up in memory of couple murdered in Trinidad

A funeral/memorial scholarship fund has been set up for the young couple found dead in Trinidad.

While the body of Geoff Barnes, 23, has been positively identified

and the autopsy complete, the fingerprints of his 22year-old Sherelle Imperio had to be sent down to Trinidad a second time, and she had not yet been identified. Until she is identified, an autopsy won't be conducted and the bodies can't be sent back.

"It's all being arranged through External Affairs and the funeral home," said a close family friend who asked not to be identified. "The services here ... we don't know when or where they will be at this time."

There will likely be two funeral services, one locally in Halton Hills is being arranged

through the McKersie-Kocher Funeral Home in Milton, and another in Toronto, being arranged through the very large Philipino community there. Sherelle Ann was a member of that community.

Barnes is the son of Thomas

Barnes and his late wife Barbara. He has two sisters, one in Vancouver and another, Valerie, who was married last Saturday to Patrick Bahen of Halton Hills. The wedding took place only days after the bodies were discovered. While

young couple at De Vry Institute of Technology, where they met. Donations can be made at any Toronto Dominion Bank.


"People are starting to send flowers and cards and in lieu of flowers and donations to other societies we're asking for this," the friend said.

Police are investigating their deaths. They were found on a remote beach in the northern part of Trinidad reported to be a place where drug dealing took place.
