

Bye Tsem set new track record at Mohawk

His early season heroics are giving every indication the Bye Tsem is on the verge of becoming a major force in the three year-old trotting colt division.

With trainer/driver Joe Hudon of Rockwood aboard, Bye Tsem tuned up for his pending stakes engagements by blazing over Mohawk Raceway on Saturday, May 14th in a track record mile of 1:56.2. Two highly rated Ontario-sired colts, Glorys Comet and Airies Canada were second and third in the \$10,000 conditioned event for non-winners of four races lifetime.

Bye Tsem, sixth at the :57.3 half, moved three-wide picking off trotter with ease to join leader Glorys Comet at the 1:27 three-quarters. A

final panel of :29.2 earned the son of Sir Taurus a 3 1/4 length decision and the new mark.

"He's very powerful, good gaited and has lots of guts," described Hudon. "I haven't had a lot of trotters, but he gives you a good feeling."

Bye Tsem's list of admirers is growing with each start. "That's a world class trotter over there," praised John Holmes who drove

runner-up Glorys Comet. "The speed is unbelievable."

First-time harness horse owner Marilyn Fromowitz of Richmond Hill purchased Bye Tsem for a bargain price of \$4,200 at Harrisburg as a yearling. "He's showed a lot all along," said Fromowitz. "We like him very much; we couldn't believe this tonight." Bye Tsem is now unbeaten in four 1994 starts and will make his stakes debut in the June 4th eliminations for the Canadian Trotting Classic at Woodbine.

The \$71,500 final of the Mohawk Pacing Series for three year-old colts on May 21st appeared wide open as the second elimination leg on May 14th produced no repeat winners.

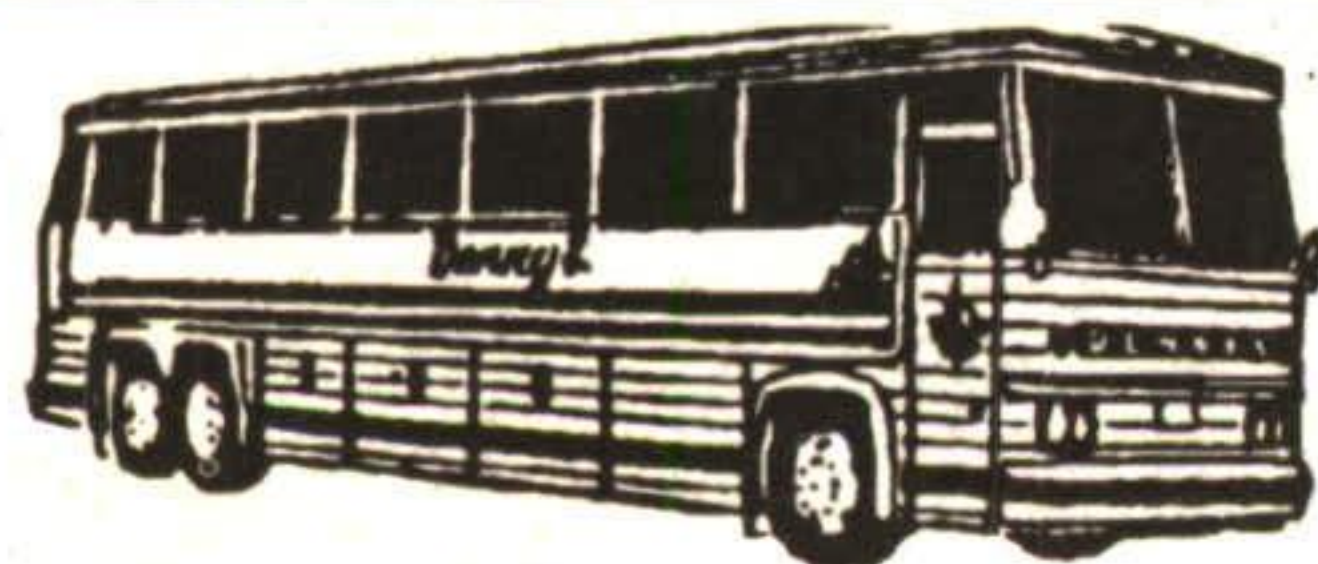
