Region buying \$735,000 software

Halton Region will update its computer services to the tune of \$735,000.

Members of the administration and finance committee voted to purchase software and training support from SAP Inc. and a database system from Oracle Corporation.

The software incorporates financial reporting, purchasing, accounts payable, budgets, capital project accounting, cost allocation, human resources and payroll.

Halton's present systems were installed in 1983 and do not meet current needs, according to a report by commissioner of finance Joe Rinaldo.

Rinaldo says in his report the new computer system would help the region to streamline processes and thereby reduced administration costs.

SAP has operated in Europe, providing program for IBM mainframes, and has only recently moved into the North American

market.

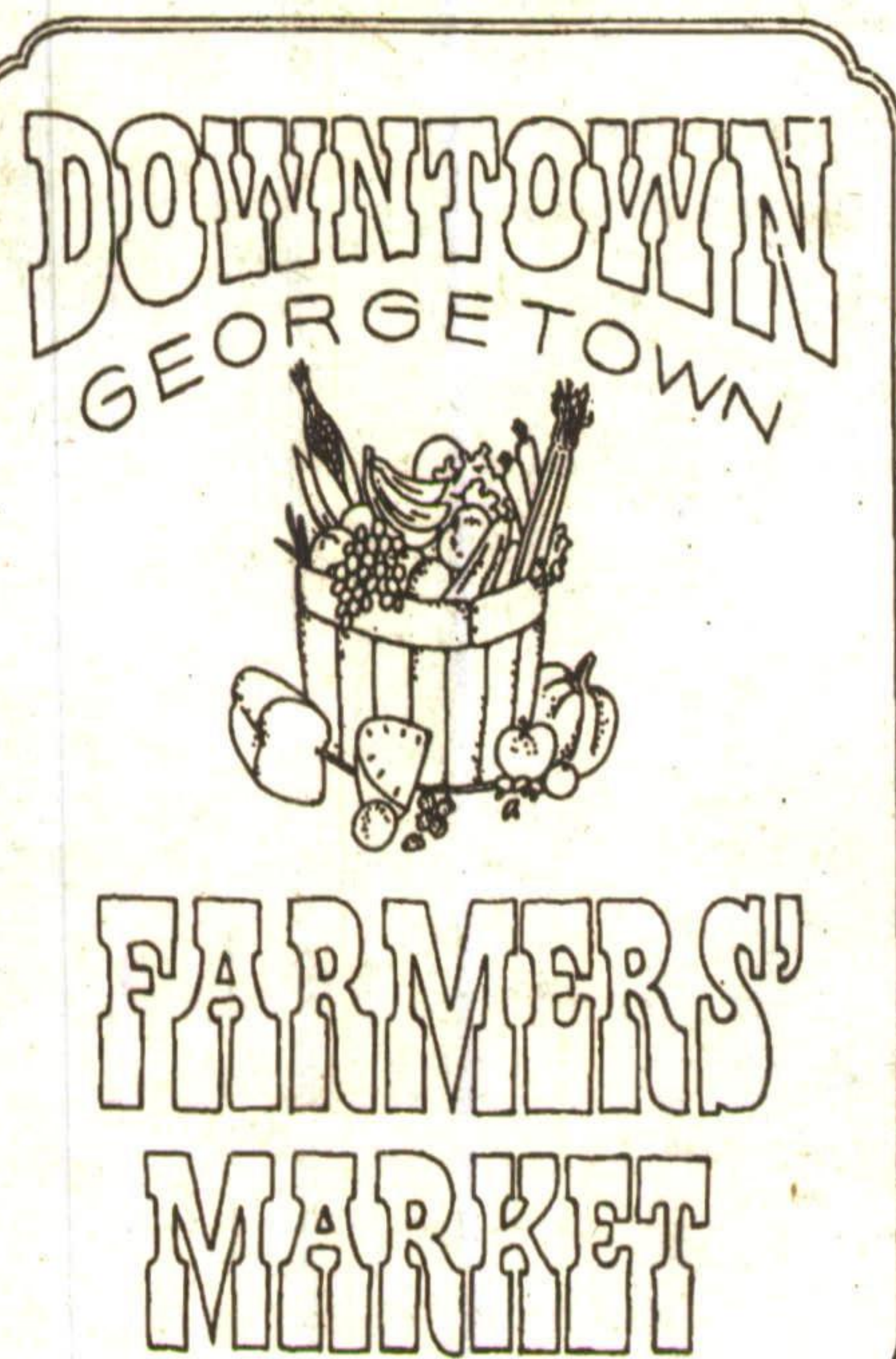
It is hoped that eventually all area municipalities in Halton will be integrated into the system to improve efficiency and reduce costs, according to Rinaldo.

"Obsolescence is the nature of the game," said Oakville councillor Keith Bird. "There's more computer capability in a 1994 car than there was in a Mercury space capsule. We'll probably have a new system only five years after getting this one."

IF YOU WEAR DENTURES

1. Avoid using pads, liners or denture adhesives to improve the fit of your dentures. If they're loose, see your dentist. Your gums, like your eyes, change as you get older. Dentures, like eyeglasses, must be adjusted or changed periodically.
2. Avoid using very hot or very cold water on your dentures, and don't let them dry out. Such extremes can cause your denture to warp.
3. Remove your dentures overnight and put them in a container filled with water. This won't cause your face to sag! It will give your gums a needed rest. Healthy gums will extend the life of your dentures.
4. Have yearly check-ups. Our office does not charge for consultations. If you follow these tips, your dentures will fit, function and look their best.
