Magician at the library

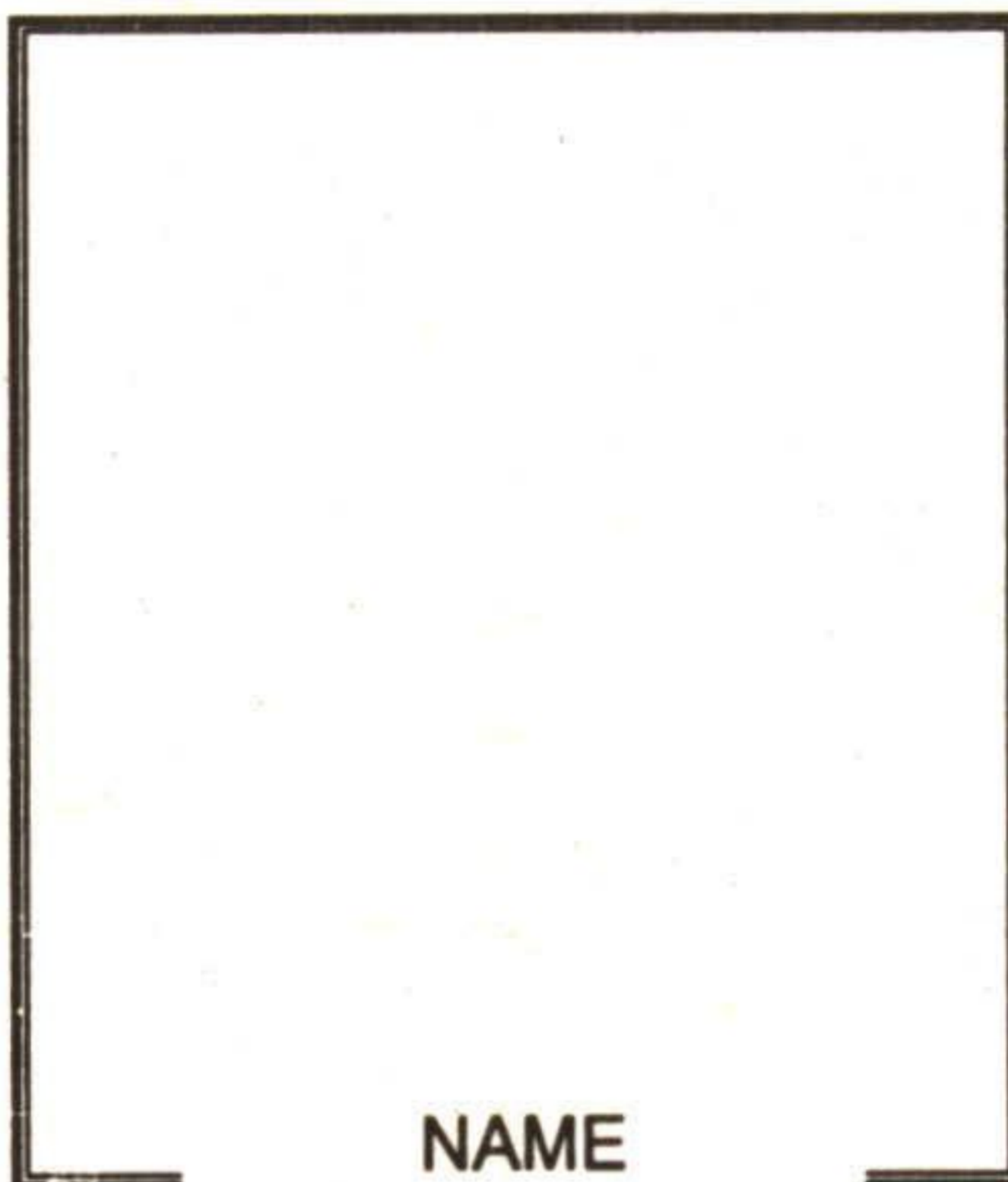
