## Georgetown water supply options narrow

Halton Hills residents got a chance to view and comment on the various options being considered by the Public Liaison Committee of the Region of Halton to provide water for Georgetown at a public meeting at the Civic Centre last week.

The committee has come up with a short-list of 13 combinations of water sources that will provide

between 2.2 and 2.7 million gallons of water per day to service the town's projected population of 40,000 people by the year 2011.

The options being considered include water from various source combinations such as the Credit River and test well 22; a reservoir on Embleton Rd. in Peel region, Test Well 22 and a well on the Sixth Line south of 15 Sideroad; the Sixth Line well and test well 22; a well in Huttonville in combination with test

wells 15 and 22; Sixth Line well and test wells 22 and 15; a reservoir on Hwy. 7 and test wells 22 and 15; water from Peel region and test wells 15 and 22; test wells 22 and 15; the Hwy. 7 reservoir, test well 22 and a well on the Sixth Line; Huttonville well and Sixth Line; water piped from Oakville; and water piped from Peel.

Benson Leung, manager of special studies for Halton Region, said the next step in the process is to

narrow that list down even further to three or four possibilities. Those options will be brought back to the public likely in October.

"From here on the next level of detail will be looked at including environmental impact, corridor selection, cost estimates and timing," said Leung.

Leung said he is hopeful the committee will be able to announce the preferred option before the end of the year.

The committee, which includes members of the public, Halton Region and town staff and representatives of Credit Valley Conservation and Halton Region Conservation Authorities, Ministry of Natural Resources, Ministry of Environment and Energy and the Department of Fisheries and Oceans, has met regularly since last November.

Leung said after the final option receives the necessary approvals the next step will be to come up with a detailed design.

It will be implemented dependent on growth in Georgetown, and the financing options worked out with developers.

"We would like to have this plan in place so approvals (for water allotments) could be given in about three years, and new development can come (on line) in five years," said Leung.

## Fire destroys \$30,000 limo
