



# Seniors sign petition

Georgetown & District Seniors Association sees a possibility that Georgetown could lose its opportunity to set up a seniors centre at The Indoor Mall, 318 Guelph St.

A complete formal application for funding has been submitted by the Recreation Department. Yet, in

spite of considerable lobbying, nothing seems to be moving.

Seniors were called upon to show their displeasure at the failure of the provincial government to provide the necessary operating grant, by signing a petition.

More than 1,200 signatures were collected. The petition has been passed on to MPP Noel Duignan who will see that the the Minister of Health gets it.
