
Keep in mind that decks and patios can also be designed to incorporate your landscaping. If you have large trees for example, consider building around them instead of avoiding them altogether

You can also have different levels of a patio, if you have varying levels of land or you can create different levels of land by making alterations to your landscaping. It's a good idea to consult a professional first, if you decide to go this route.

When planning your deck or patio, don't forget to think about aspects of your home or yard that you want to accentuate - like the french doors opening up from the family room— or camouflage like



the neighbors' unsightly storage shed. You can be very creative with privacy fencing.

If you're handling the job yourself, remember to check and see if any building permits are required. Or, if you're hiring a contractor to

do the job, make sure all the necessary permits are obtained.

Materials

If you're building a deck, do some research on the different materials available. Many homeowners opt for pressure treated wood because it's very affordable, durable and resists decay.

Other materials like cedar, are available as well. Consult with the experts at your local building supply store, or your contractor, to help you decide on the material you want to use.

You'll also have to decide if you need railings (a must if you have youngsters) and depending on the height of your deck stairs.

If you're installing a patio, you have a wide variety of materials and patterns to choose from: brick, stone, field stone and pre-formed concrete squares are all popular options. Choose something that


compliments you home and surrounding elements. For instance, if you have a home which is faced in stone, you may not want to use red, interlocking stone in your patio. You may want to opt for grey-colored stone instead.

And don't forget to carefully consider pattern and texture if you're using interlocking brick or stone. There is an endless variety to choose from.
