Georgetown Fox Run preparation underway

Terry Fox was an 18-year-old student at Simon Fraser University when he found out that he had a cancerous tumor in his right knee. While lying in the hospital after having his leg amputated six inches above the knee, he decided that "Somewhere, the hurting must stop."

On April 12, 1980 in St. John's Newfoundland, Terry Fox began his Marathon of Hope, the hope for a cure for cancer. He ran 5,564 km in 143 days before his run was halted due to cancer spreading to his lungs. Although his life sadly ended on June 28, 1981, one month short of his 23rd birthday, his dream has never died.

Each year, on the second Sunday of September participants across the world join together to walk, run, cycle jog or wheel in the Marathon

of Hope to raise money for cancer research.

The setting for the 14th Annual Terry Fox Run will be the Georgetown Fairground on Sunday, September 18, 9 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. on a well marked 8 km course through the city or on the fairgrounds track from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.

The emphasis is on participation and not on competition.

Refreshments will be available throughout the run and there will be ongoing activities to amuse young and old alike. A barbecue hosted by the Georgetown Rotary Club will feature food and refreshments and will take place between 10:30 a.m. and noon.

Pledge sheets will be available at your local chartered banks. Don't miss the fun!

Pleads guilty to fraud

The former owner of Remax Suburban Inc. in Georgetown, David Soal, pleaded guilty in Milton district court on Wednesday, June 29, to the charge of fraud over \$1,000.

Soal, who owned the real estate company in 1990, is to be sentenced on Monday Sept. 7.

The charge relates to payroll deductions police say Soal made from the employees at the real estate company that year to be forwarded to Revenue Canada.

Police say the money, in excess of \$100,000 was never paid to Revenue Canada.

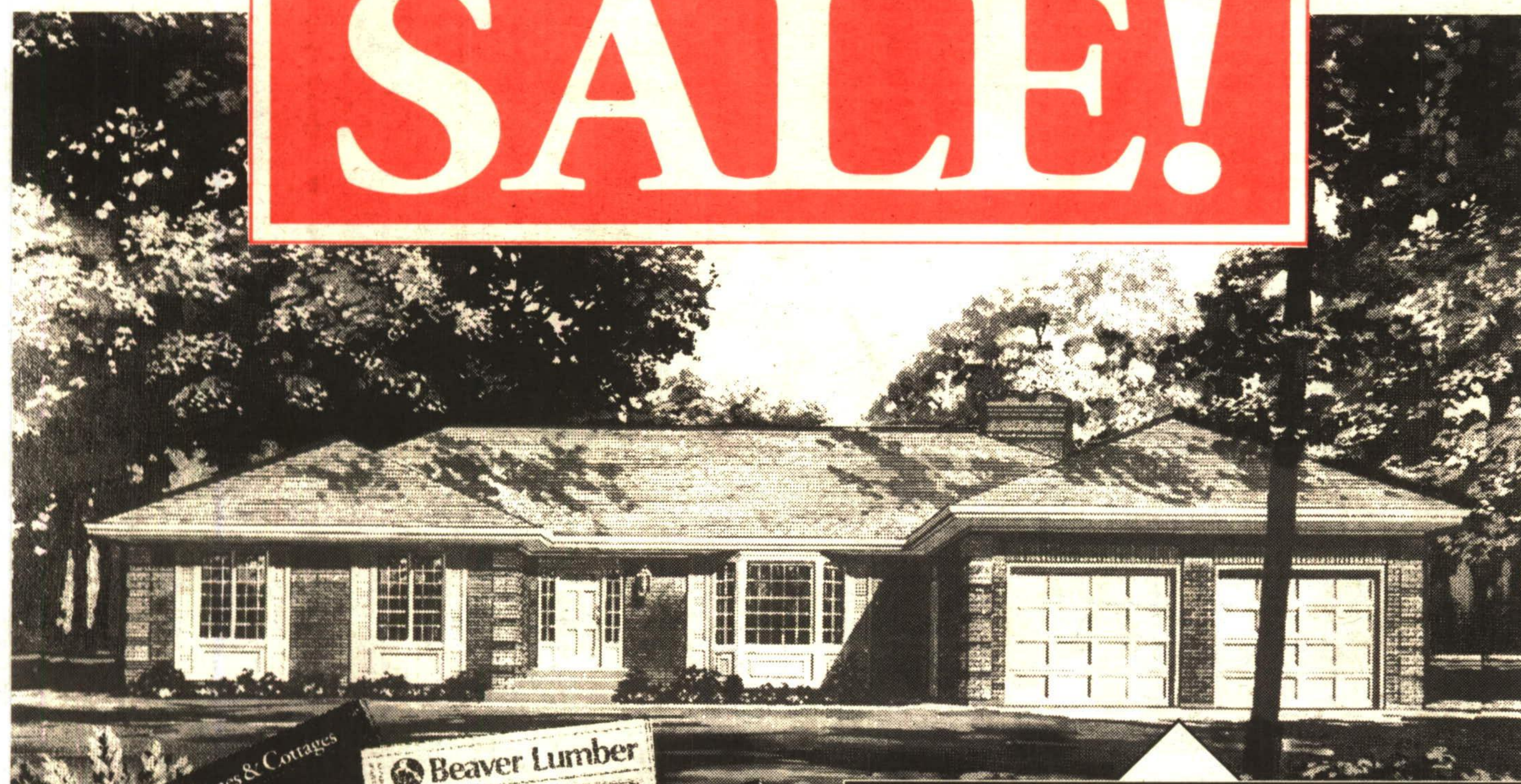

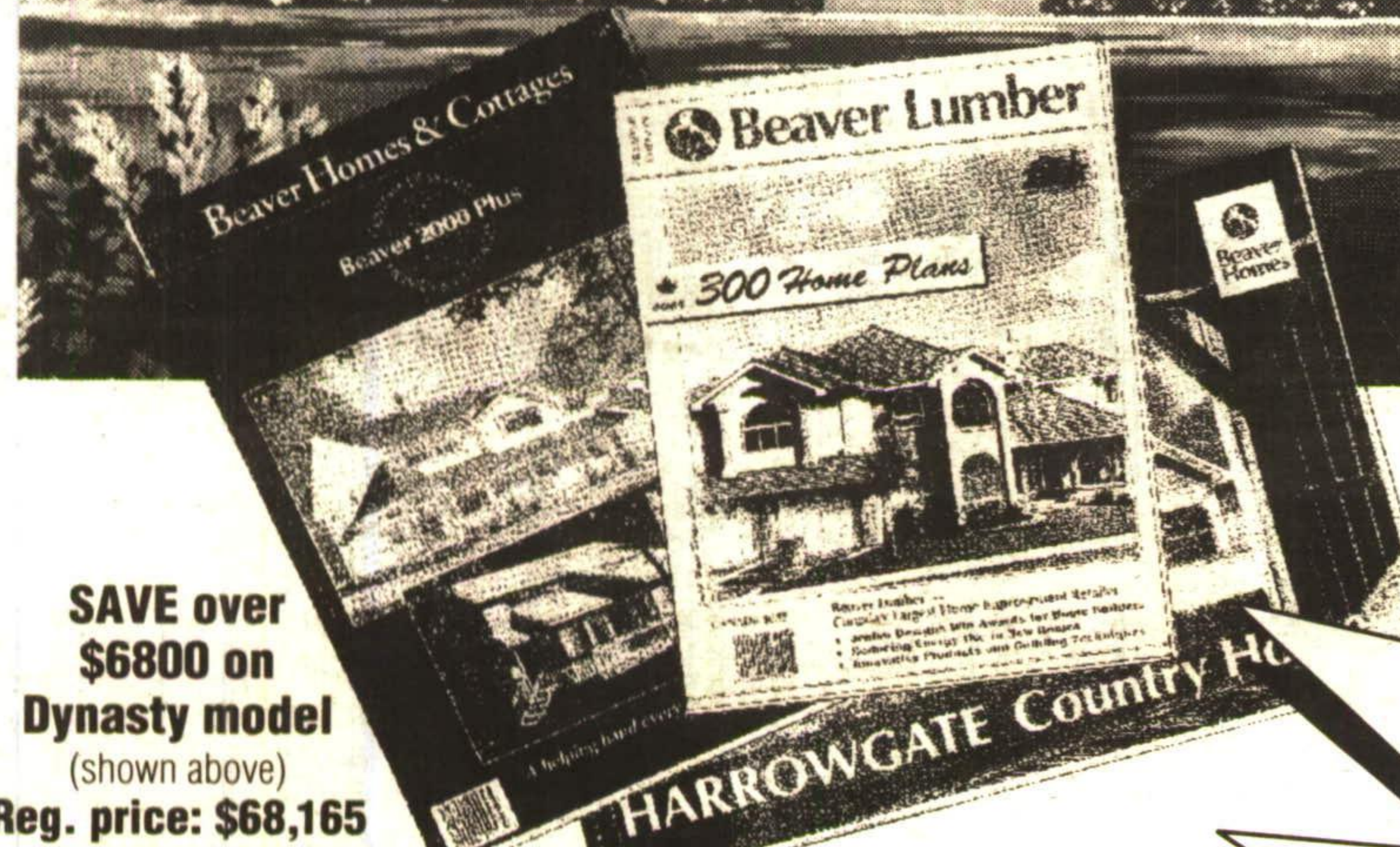
