Sinclair, a certified electrolysis, provides services to both men and women. Unwanted bikini line, facial and back hair are the problems her clients often see her for.

She explained electrolysis was invented more than 100 years

ago, and is the only permanent method of removing unwanted facial and body hair.

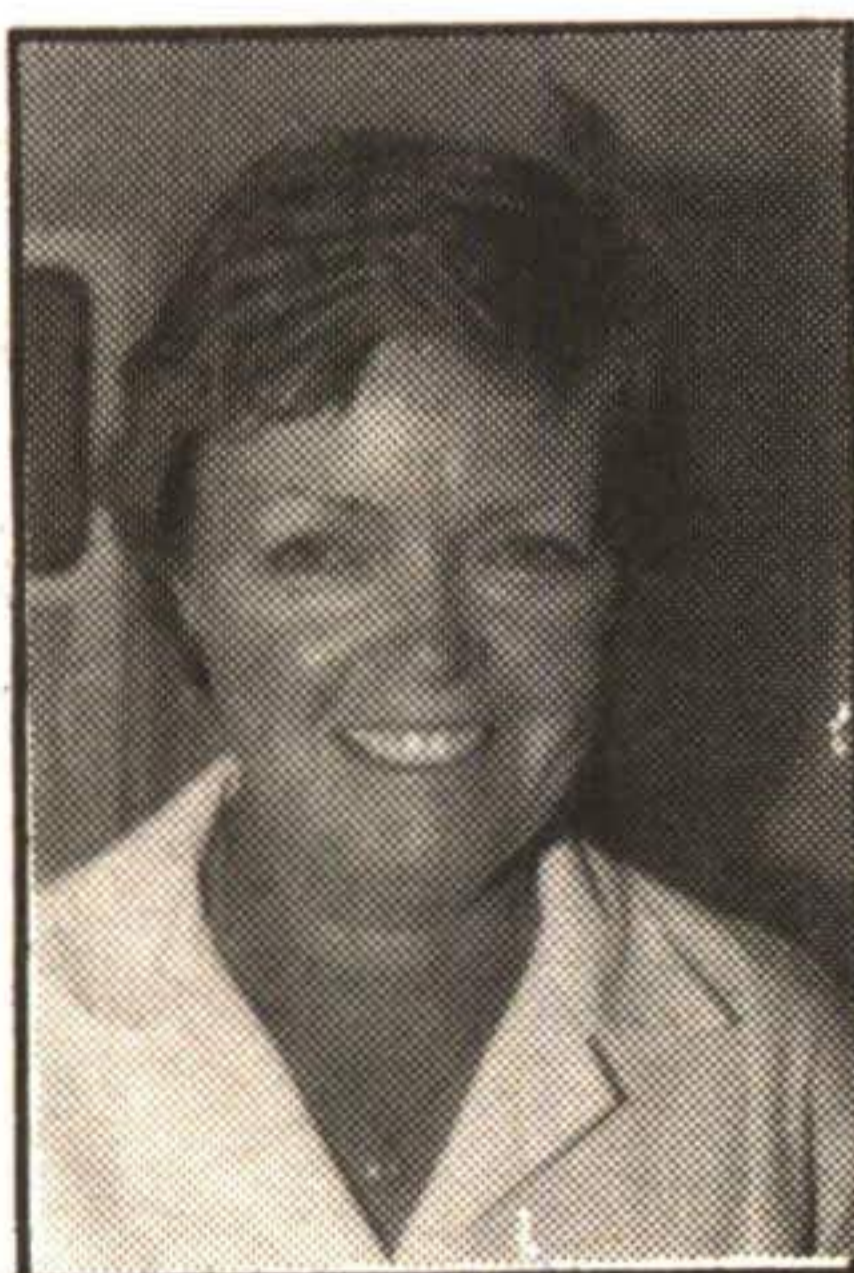
"It is achieved by inserting a tiny probe into the hair follicle. A combination of heat from the probe and moisture in the hair

follicle severs the blood vessels from the papilla eliminating the possibility of nourishment. The hair is then removed harmlessly with a forcep."

Sinclair said pain levels of people who have electrolysis vary from person to person. What most people feel is a little warmth, the warmer it is, the more effective the treatment will be.

All instruments used in the treatment are cleaned and sterilized. Only disposable needles and gloves are used.
