FEELING CORNERED? Rev. Asbil appointed to Oakville church

The Right Reverend Walter Asbil, Bishop of Niagara, announced the appointment of the Reverend Andrew Asbil as rector of the Anglican Church of the Incarnation, Oakville, effective October 15. Rev. Asbil is rector of St. Alban's in Acton.

The Reverend Andrew Asbil graduated from the University of Waterloo in 1985 with a Bachelor of Science degree, and a Master of Divinity with Honours from Huron College in London. Andrew was ordained by Bishop John Bothwell as deacon on June 5, 1988 and priest

on May 7, 1989. After ordination, Andrew served as assistant curate at St. George's, Guelph, and during his ministry there, he served as an on-call chaplain at the Guelph General Hospital and a volunteer chaplain at the Guelph Correctional Centre.

In January of 1991, he became rector of St. Alban's in Acton. He has served the diocese as a member of the Division of Congregational Support Coordinating Team, the staff of the Niagara Youth Conference, and has been a co-chair of the Youth Synod

Organizing Committee. In the wider community, he has served as a board member of Renison College, University of Waterloo, the Acton Support Services and Information Centre, and the Halton Sexual Abuse Program.

Andrew has a particular interest in both story-telling ministry and clown ministry, and will bring to Oakville a wealth of experience in these areas as well as offering creative pastoral and priestly ministry. Andrew and his wife, Catherine, will be moving to Oakville in early October.

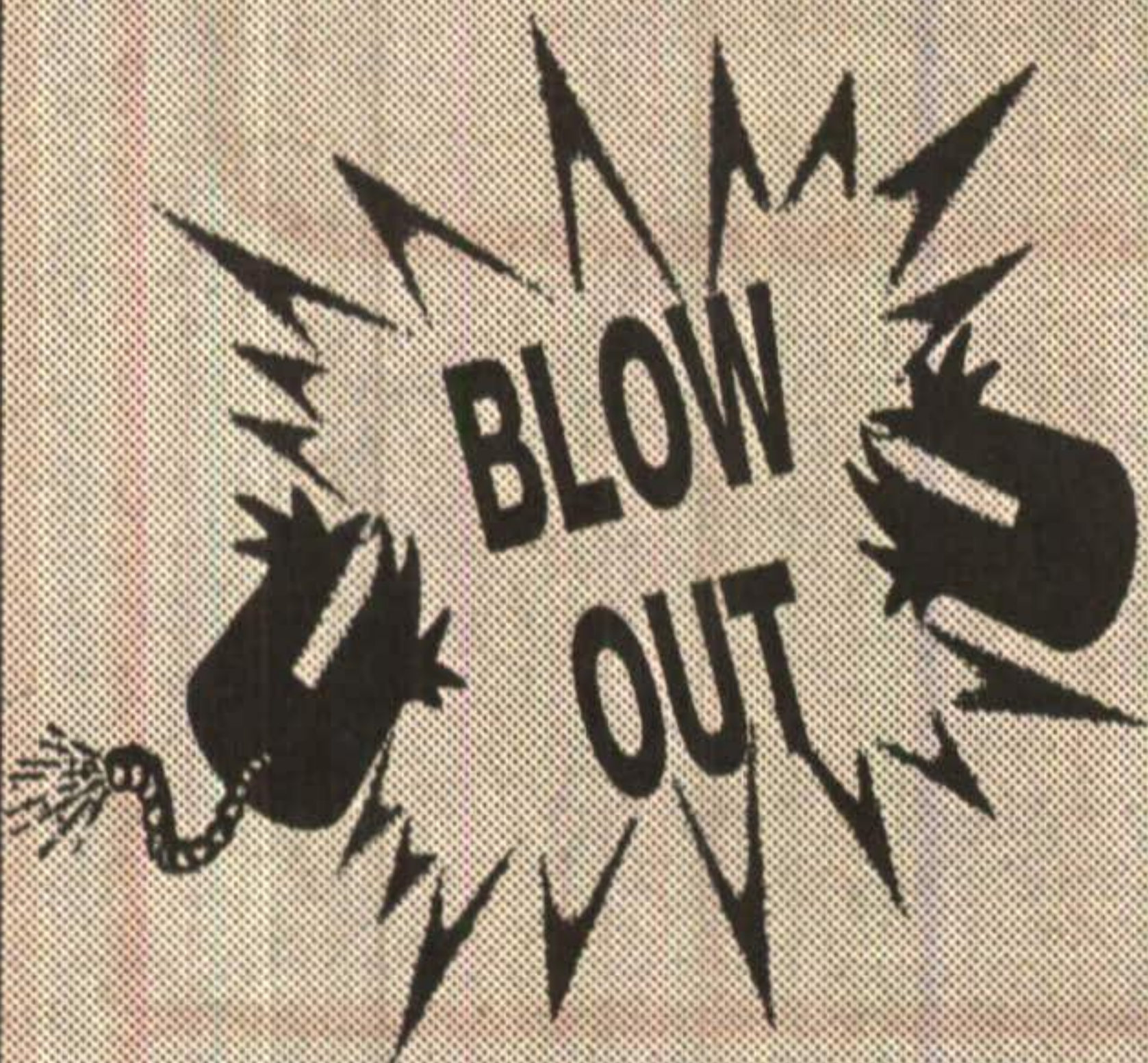

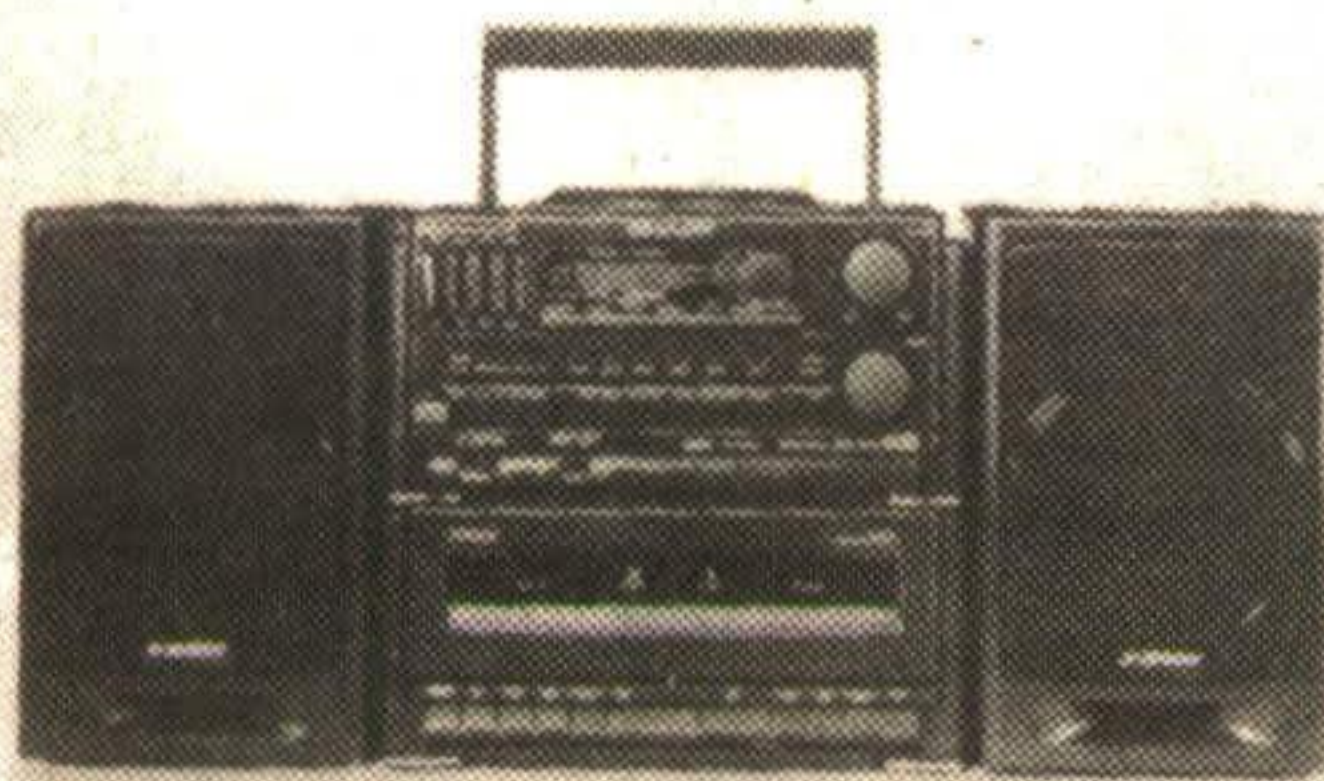

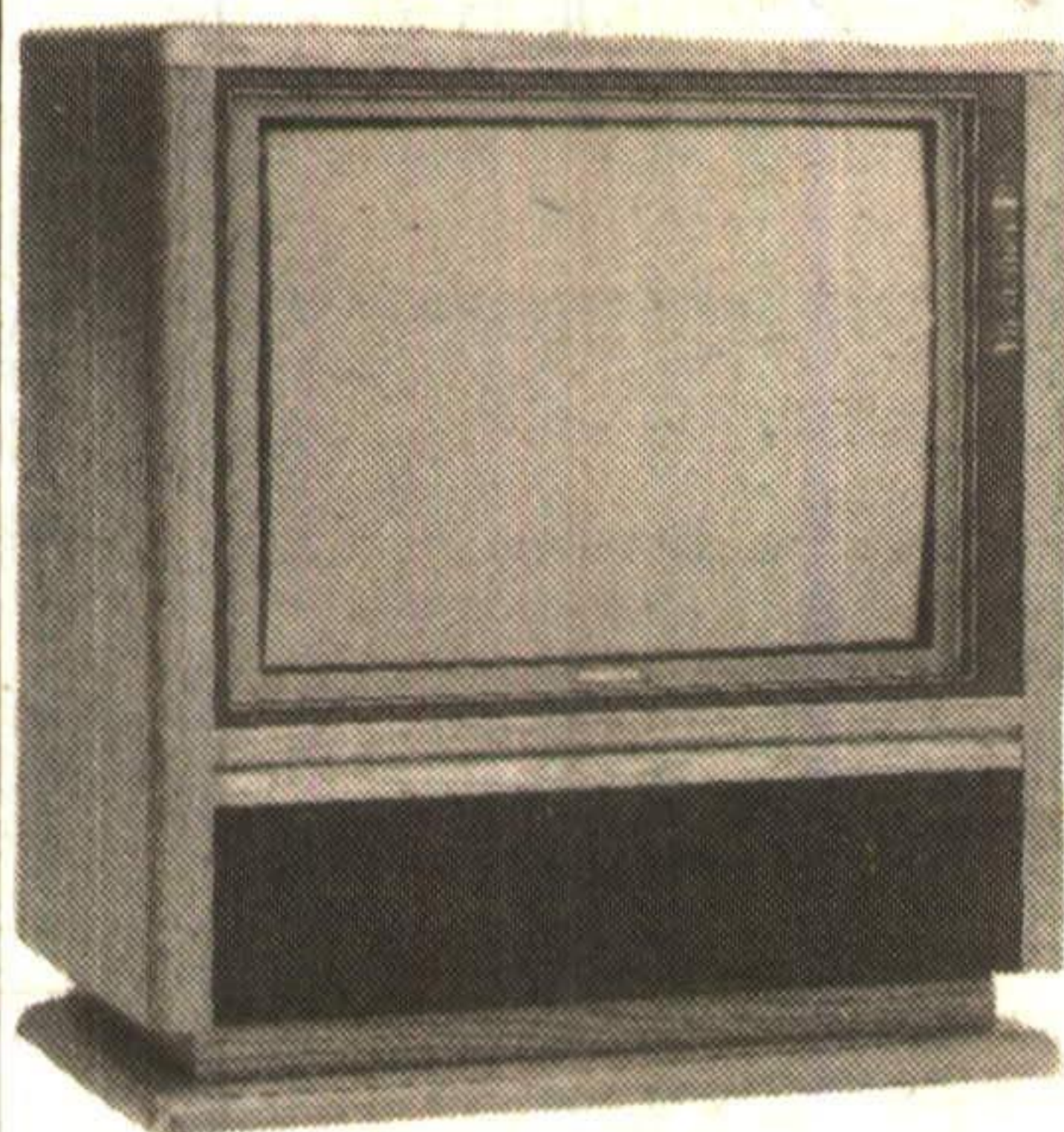
