

Gary J. McCaslin Harris says Tories will slash taxes, create jobs

Lower taxes, more jobs and a balanced budget. Sound too good to be true? Mike Harris says it isn't.

The Ontario Progressive Conservative Party leader said his Common Sense Revolution will do all these things, re-igniting the province's economy in five

years. "These are policies that will step Ontario to the top of the heap," Harris said in Milton recently.

The plan, which he outlined during a PC fundraiser at Trafalgar Golf and Country Cub, calls for a 30 per cent cut to provincial income tax rates. It also knocks down government spending by 20 per cent and promises to create more than 725,000 jobs.

Under the plan, Harris said income tax cuts would be implemented over three years — half in the first year.

"The plan will give Ontario the lowest provincial income tax rates in Canada. For an average, middleclass Ontario household, this will mean tax cuts of more than \$4,000 in the first three years alone."

The plan calls for a reduction in the number of MPPs from 130 to 99 by using the same boundaries used to elect federal MPs. It also calls for the abolishment of MPPs' pen-

Further cuts would break down

government barriers to job creation investment and economic growth, Harris said.

Immediate action would be taken to abolish the "job-killing payroll health tax" for small businesses, freeze Ontario Hydro rates for five years cut Workers' Compensation Board premiums for all employers by 5 per cent.

He said the plan, which took almost four years to develop, results from conversations he has had with average Ontarians over the last few years.

"It's time for government to make the same types of changes all of us have had to make in our own families and in our jobs."

Vandals appear to have pulled an alarm at 9 Carruthers Rd. last Friday at 5:24 p.m.


Stuck in sewer grate






