**MELT IN THE MOUTH BBQ SPARERIBS**

**BBQ SAUCE**

- 2 tablespoons butter
  - 1 onion finely chopped
  - 2 tablespoons red wine vinegar
  - 1/4 cup brown sugar
  - 3 tablespoons lemon juice
  - 1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper
  - 1 cup ketchup
  - 2 tablespoons Worcestershire sauce
  - 1 teaspoon dry mustard
  - 1 teaspoon celery salt
- pork back or side ribs
- 1) Cut ribs into sections of 3 ribs each, place in large pot, cover with water & bring to boil
  - 2) Reduce to simmer, cover & cook for 1 hour
  - 3) Drain ribs & place in shallow baking dish
  - 4) In saucepan, melt butter then brown onion. Add remaining ingredients; simmer 3 minutes stirring constantly
  - 5) Pour sauce over ribs, cover & refrigerate at least one hour or preferably overnight - turning occasionally
  - 6) BBQ or broil for 15 mins. cut in between bones & serve.
- Makes enough for 20 ribs. Do not double sauce recipe - it becomes to hot!

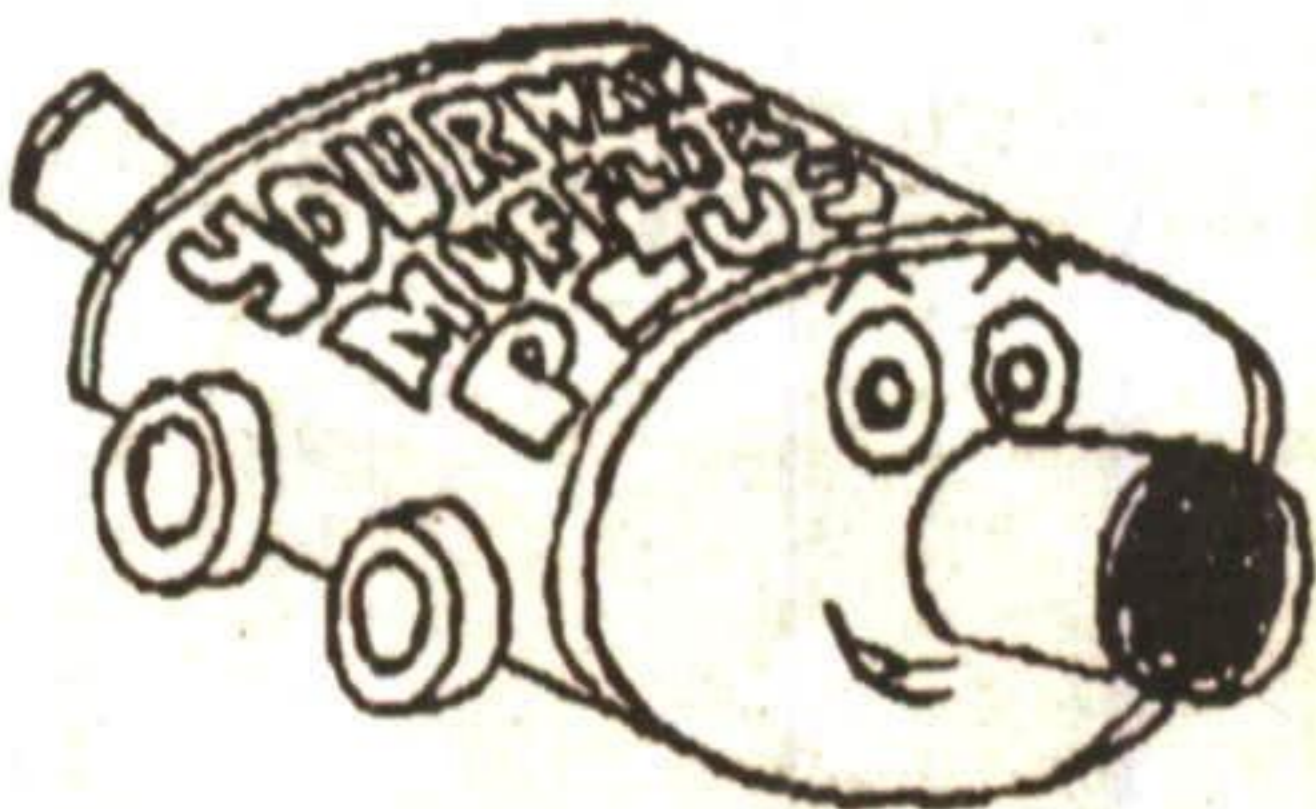

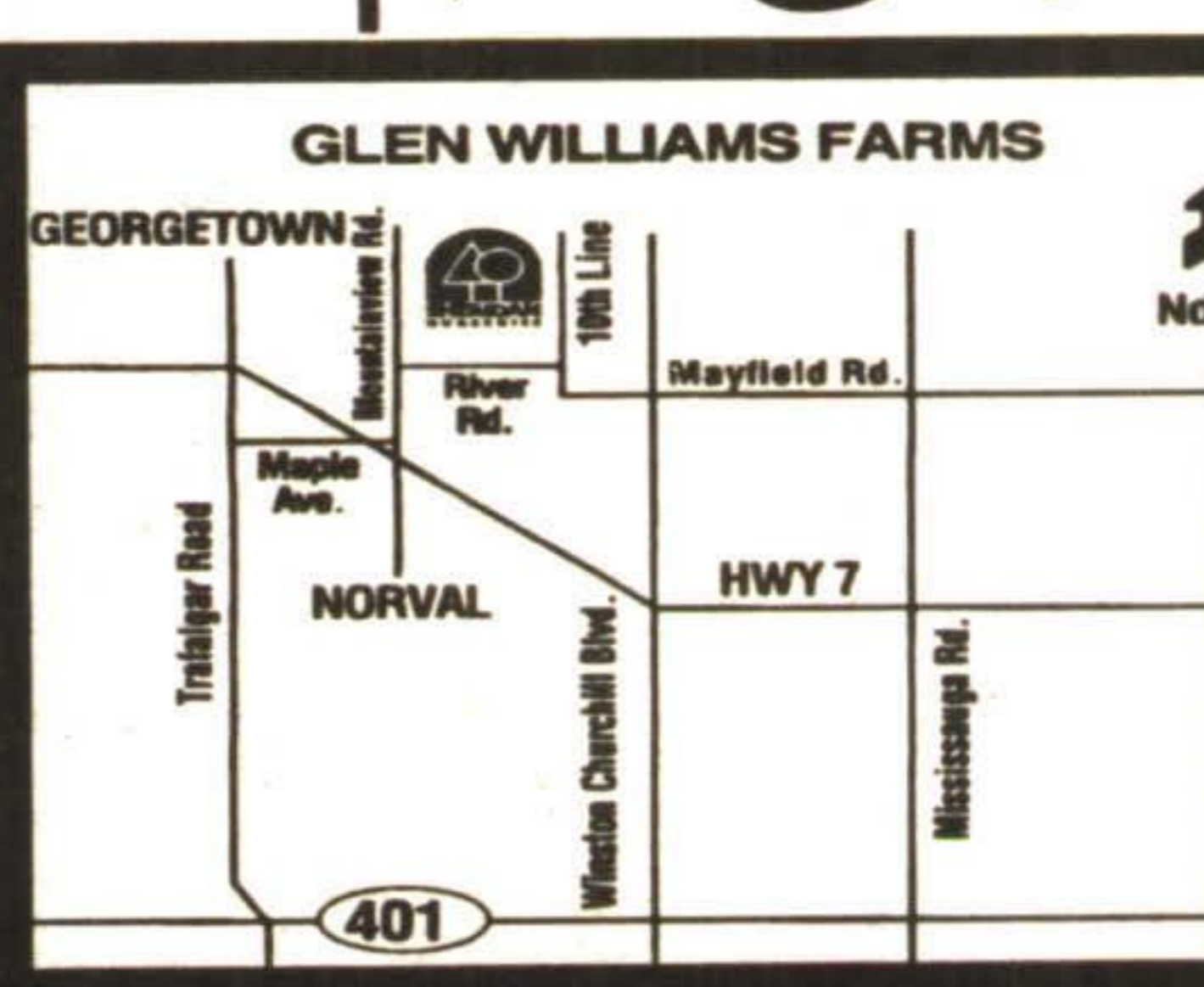
