Looking for a new hobby? Want to create something? The Credit Valley Artisans may have just the thing for you.

There's new ways of looking at watercolor in a Watercolour and Mixed Media Workshop for Adults on Sunday, Sept. 25, 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. Bev Didur will be the instruc-

tor for this \$25 workshop (\$22 for CVA members). A supply list is available upon registration — and bring a lunch.

Prefer to see things in black and white? Try the Pencil and Charcoal Drawing course taught on six Thursdays by Sheri Tenaglia-Grandin. The dates are Sept. 22, 29,

Oct. 6, 13, 20, 27, 7-9 p.m. This course costs \$53 (\$47 for CVA members). A supply list of approximately \$20 is available upon registration.

Your talents lie in another direction? How about beginner weaving? Instructor Else Staal Nielsen will provide basic instruction in weaving, how to set up a loom, warping and weaving a sample. All basic principles plus drafting. The course will be held on five Wednesdays Oct. 26 Nov. 2, 9, 16, 24., either mornings, 9-11:30 a.m. or evenings, 7-9:30 p.m. The cost is \$62 (CVA-\$56) with supplies costing approximately \$15 to \$20, payable to instructor.

Get your hands dirty with Intermediate. Instructor Glynis Milligan will teach potting on the wheel including forming the basic shapes, design, coloring and glazing of pots. Handbuilding will cover the basic methods for making forms. This course will be held on 10 Wednesdays, Sept. 21, 28 Oct. 5, 12, 19, 26, Nov. 2, 9, 16, 12:30-3:30 p.m. (Nov. 16 will be one hour only). Or you can take the course on 10 Thursdays, Sept. 22, 29, Oct. 6, 13, 20, 27, Nov. 3, 10, 17, 7-10 p.m. (Nov. 17 will be for one hour only.) The cost for this course is \$115 (CVA-\$102) and includes clay and two


Susan Kerr is the instructor for Stained Glass: Beginners and




