

Chudleigh bidding for PC nomination

Ted Chudleigh complained that he didn't like the way the province was being run, and someone asked him, "Why don't you do something about it?"

That question prompted him to spring into action, he says.

Chudleigh is the first person to announce his candidacy for the provincial Progressive Conservative Party nomination in the Halton North riding.

A longtime PC supporter, the 51year-old Milton man says he strongly backs Ontario PC leader Mike Harris' 'Common Sense Revolution,' a plan to cut taxes and create jobs.

"Personally, I'm convinced that Mike Harris can make it work," he says.

The province's school system escalates in cost, he says, yet some graduates cannot read or write.

Private business continues to be stifled with red tape, high taxes and government bureaucracy, he says, while buildings remain vacant, searching for tenants.

"This erodes our tax base, causes high employment, and, worst of all, robs individuals of their selfesteem and respect."

Executive vice-president of the Ontario Processors Food Association, Chudleigh says he believes Harris' 'Common Sense Revolution" will rebuild the province.

The plan promises to cut government spending by 20 per cent and create 725,000 jobs in Ontario in the private sector over the next four years, as well as balancing for budget. It also calls for a 30 per cent income tax reduction.

"Mike Harris is calling for a revolution to change the way the Ontario government is working," he says. "I believe in this revolution and am committed to working to see it become a reality."

Chudleigh lives on Town Line in Milton Heights with his wife Tonia. The couple has two sons, 28 and 26,

and a daughter 24. Politics is in Chudleigh's blood. His grandfather is the late Tom Kennedy, who served as Minister of Agriculture for the province as a PC for many years, starting in the late 1920's. A great uncle was an MPP in Mississauga South.
