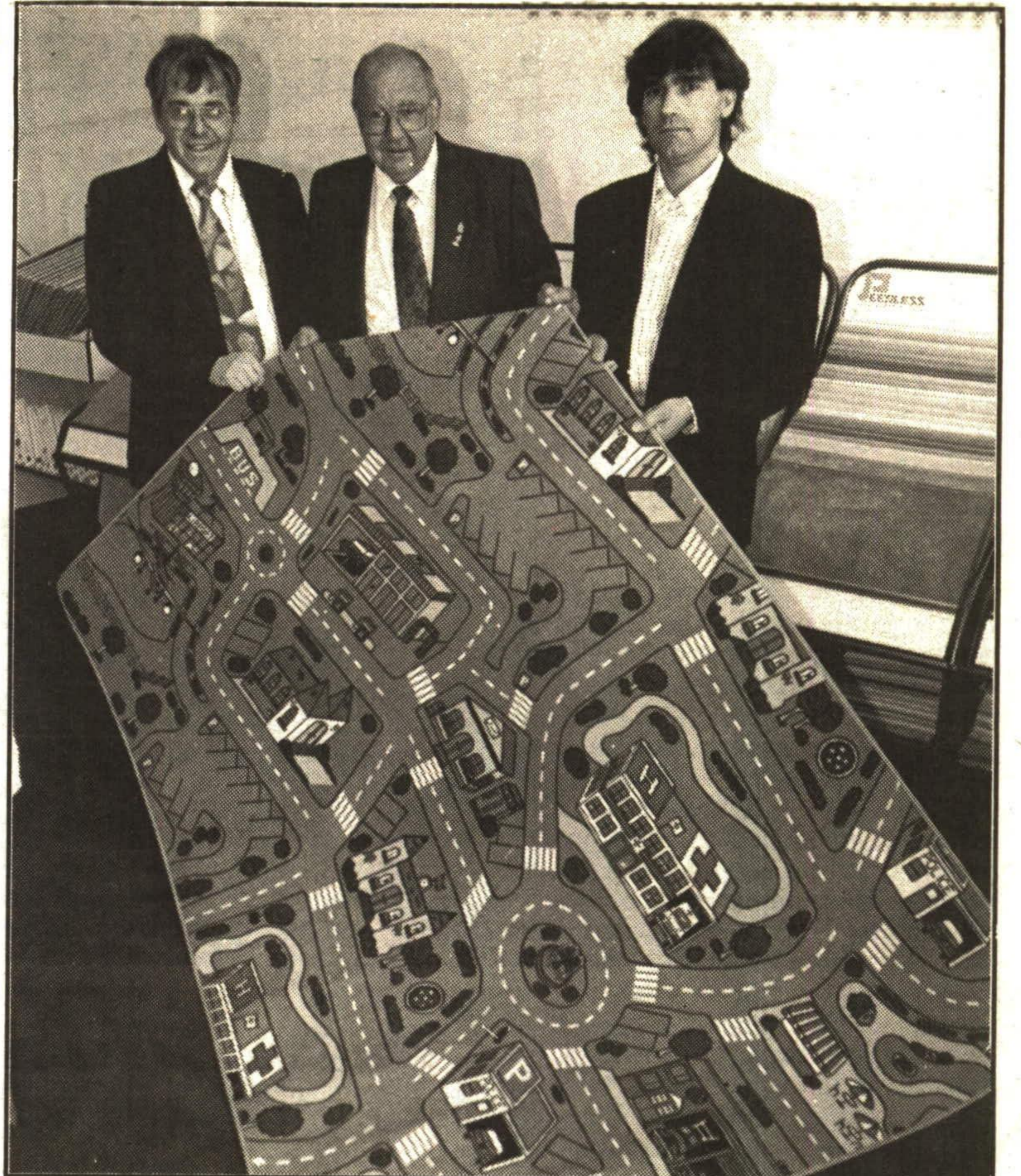

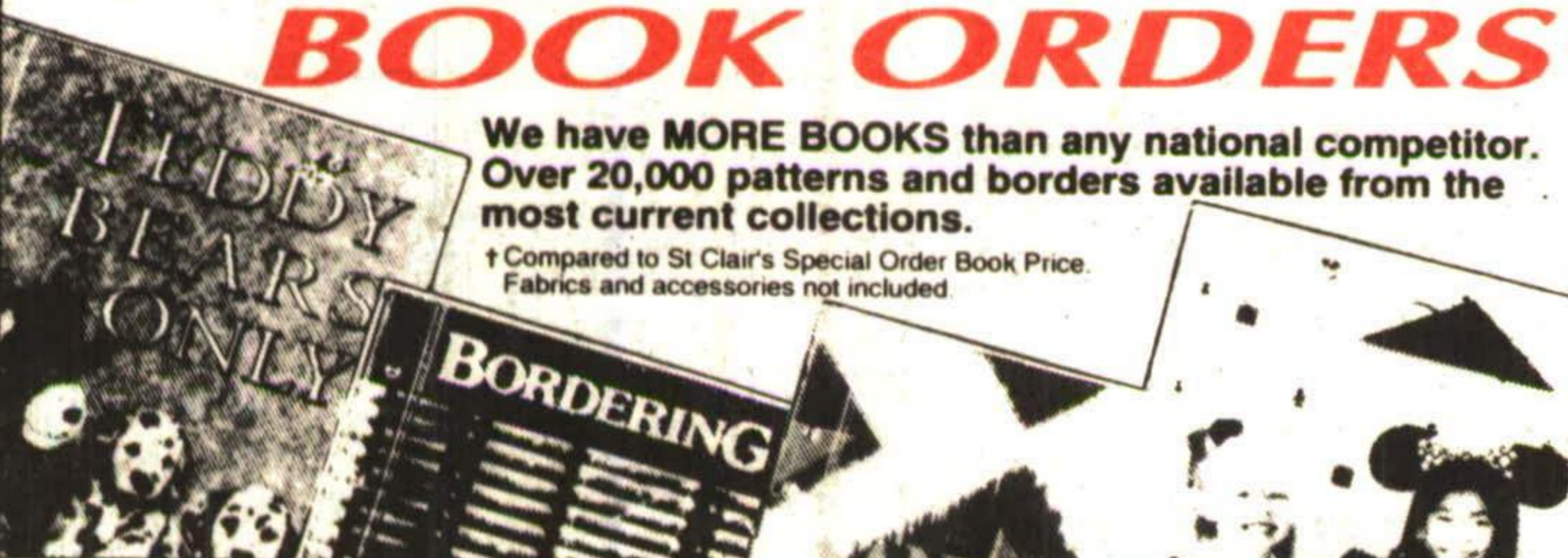

RECAPPING THE SUMMER OF 1994

Well, here ends another summer! Even though the season was 2 weeks behind this year, once it got going we had great weather, with the exception of the dry weather in July and August, lawns did fairly well.

Damage caused by lawn chinchbugs this year was more noticeable over last year, with a lot of lawns needing reseeding. We also had a wide spread infestation of Sod Webworm and Cutworm. These insects primarily infested lawns which were less than 6 years old while the famous White Grub, damaged lawns in the older parts of town.

The occurrence of disease in lawns this year very high. The diseases requiring dry, humid weather were very persistent while the cool, wet weather diseases were only visible in the spring and fall. The summer time diseases unfortunately came on so fast and did so much damage that most lawns needed some seeding in order to repair the damage. Once the hot, humid weather disappeared, we did manage to get quite a bit of rain which helped lawns tremendously.

Now that the summer is pretty well over, you should be preparing your lawn for the winter. Even though this is our last Turf Tip for 1994, our office is open all winter for anyone who has any questions. Once again it has been a pleasure bringing you our weekly Turf Tips this year and we hope they have been helpful and educational. See you in the spring!
