Half million \$ question

The children of Robert Little Public School will be able to get a bowl of cereal and a glass of juice every day before school starts.

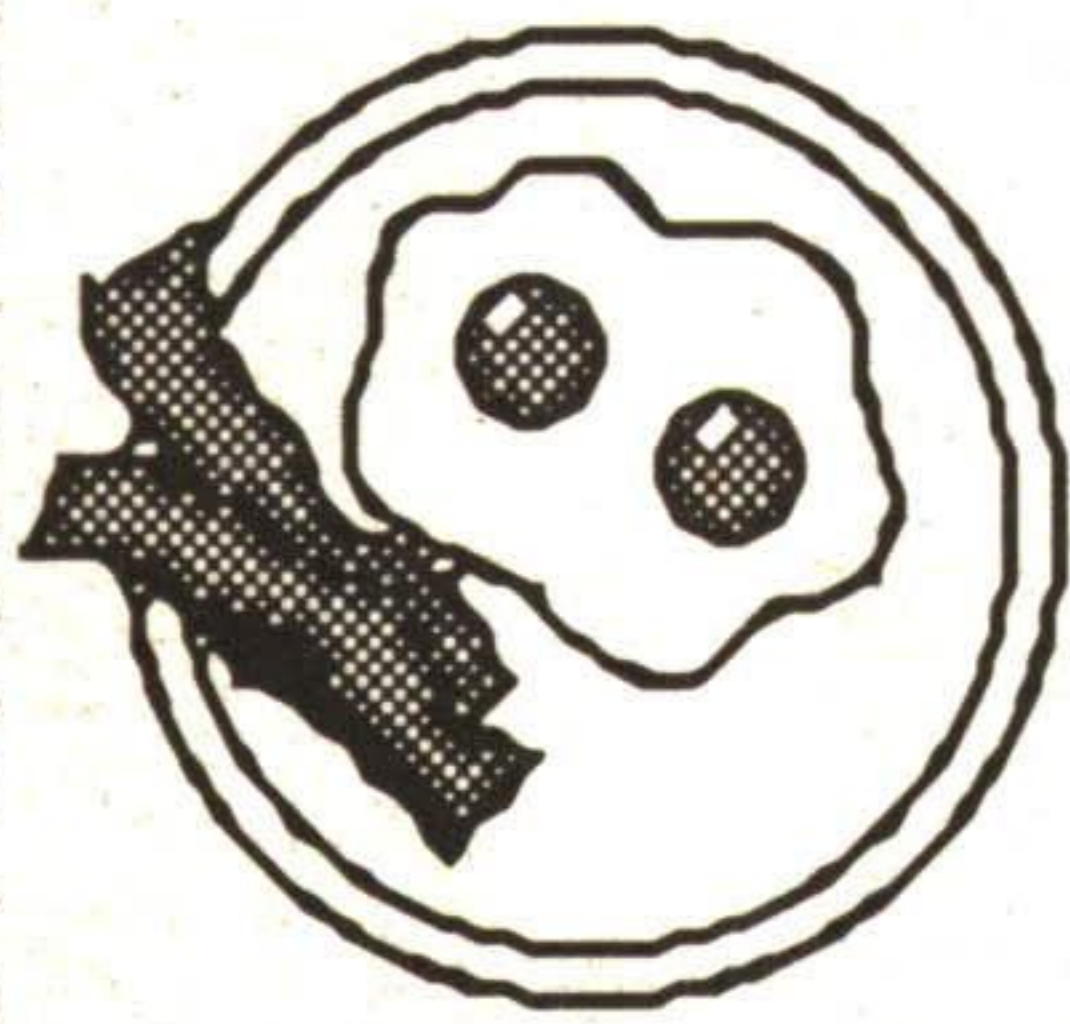
This program was started January 1993 at St. Alban's Church in response to the increasing demand placed on the Foodshare food bank in Acton. The response to this program was tremendous! More than 4,000 breakfasts were served in just 18 months. Organizers were especially overwhelmed by the generosity of Actonians. Many individuals, businesses and churches donated food, money and their time to serve the breakfasts.

The organizers of the Dine & Dash Acton Children's Breakfast Club decided to move the location to better meet the needs of the chil-

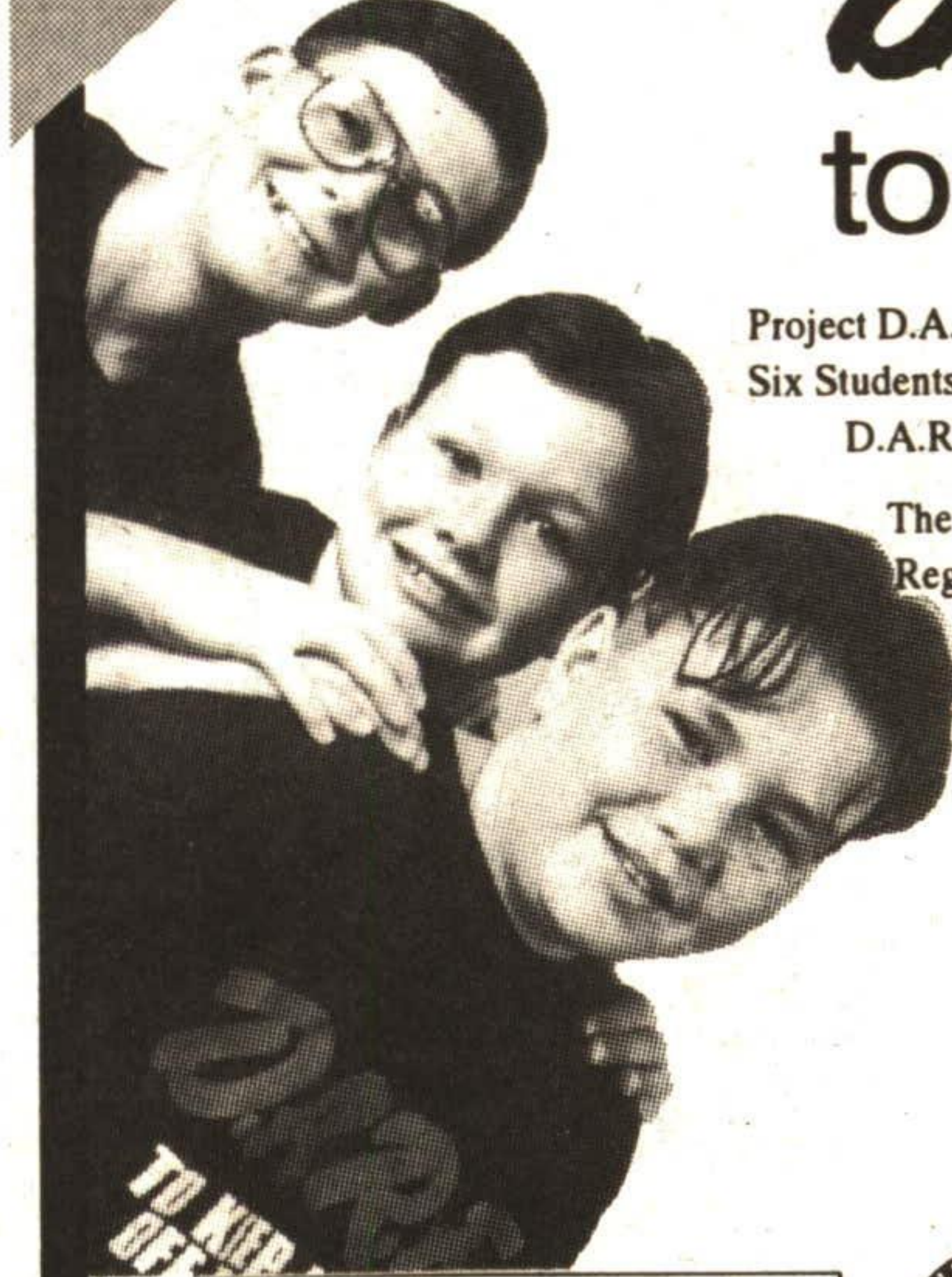
dren. Breakfast will now be served in the school from 8:30 a.m. until school starts. By changing our location and hours of operation, organizers hope to catch those children who come by bus or walk to school on an empty stomach.

Any child in Acton who goes to school is welcomed to come in for breakfast. We offer breakfast to all the children of Robert Little School, so that there will not be any discrimination or stigma placed on children who come from lower families and need this service. For those who can afford it, a nominal fee of 25 cents is charged for breakfast.
