New policy for Town

Notice to all individuals and organizations who are planning to run an event on town premises where alcohol is to be served.

With the implementation of the Corportate Alcohol Management Policy, all functions will be required to have a minimum of one bartender to serve on duty at all times, who is certified in the Server Intervention Program (SIP).

To assist individuals and organizations who are planning events where alcohol is to be served, the Recreation and Parks Department will be offering SIP in conjunction with the Addiction Research Foundation.

Affiliated organization members are eligible for a 50 per cent rebate upon successful course completion.

Who should take SIP? Bartenders, waiters, waitresses, bouncers, owners, managers, banquet staff, volunteers with Special Occasion Permits, recreation facility managers and staff.

Course one will be held October 13, at the Halton Hills Cultural Centre, 6-11 p.m. The fee is \$37.45. For more information call 873-2600,






