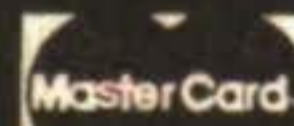

Water expert headlines POWER's AGM Nov. 3

All are invited to hear Jim Bishop at the POWER annual general meeting, Thursday, November 3 at the Georgetown District High School.

Bishop has an extensive background in water resources, pollution impacts, and remedial action to correct water, terrestrial and sediment contamination.

Presently working with a private consulting firm, Bishop has spent 24 years with the Ministry of the Environment as a senior scientist. Some of his responsibilities have included, assistant director of

Research and Development involved with acid rain, wastewater and drinking water research and director of the Water Resources Branch where he directed the activities of about 240 scientists, engineers and staff in developing specific programs such as the Great Lakes Remedial Action Plans, Fish Contaminants, MISA, and the Drinking Water Protection Program.

The business meeting will begin at 8 p.m. with the speaker expected to begin after 8:30 p.m. There will be an opportunity for questions.

Feedback volunteers pick 75 bushels of fall apples

Thanksgiving Monday meant apples picking from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. for the charity, Feedback Canada, the domestic program of Canadian Feed the Children.

Williams Orchard, located between Milton and Georgetown, regularly invites volunteers to pick their own apples and this year the Thanksgiving Day excess was donated to Feedback Canada who left the site with their truck packed full of some of the best quality apples Ontario has to offer. Seventy five bushels

were picked that day and Feedback Canada says the needy they serve were extremely grateful for the fresh produce.

Feedback Canada supplies more than 50,000 pounds of fresh produce per month to approximately 50 agencies and groups in Ontario who cater to the hungry. They work seven days a week and are able to deliver food to those who need it most within hours. Feedback Canada moved more than one million pounds of fresh produce since its initial creation in May 1992.
