Haunted Hayride is food bank fundraiser

Top O'Trafalgar Farm will once again be ghoulish hosts for the most terrifying, heart stopping, gut wrenching haunted Halloween nightmare.

This year, the Haunted Hayride from hell will be run by 30 Erin High School and area kids.

Lora Bender said, "last year my mom did the Haunted Hayride. Some of my friends were over and we were telling them about it, and so we decided to get together and have the ride."

The ride, especially made for the weak hearted, will include, "a guy in a car accident, monks, witches, people who were shot, a swamp monster and more."

Those who dare to ride the Haunted Hayride can do so on October 22, and again on October 28 and 29 from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. every

half hour on both weekends.

Bender said they already have three bookings with 30 people per spooky booking. Bender estimates they will have over 100 people this year.

For a frightening price of \$5 for adults and \$4 for children under 10, will get you in for the ride and a complimentary drink and snack to calm your shattered nerves.

Bender said a donation to the local Erin Food Bank will see a \$1 knocked off the price of admission.

"The funds from the ride will go towards paying for our costumes, makeup and things like that," Bender said.

To get to Top O'Trafalgar Farm, take Trafalgar Road, 9 km. north of Hwy 7 or 2 km. south of Hwy. 24, just outside of Erin.

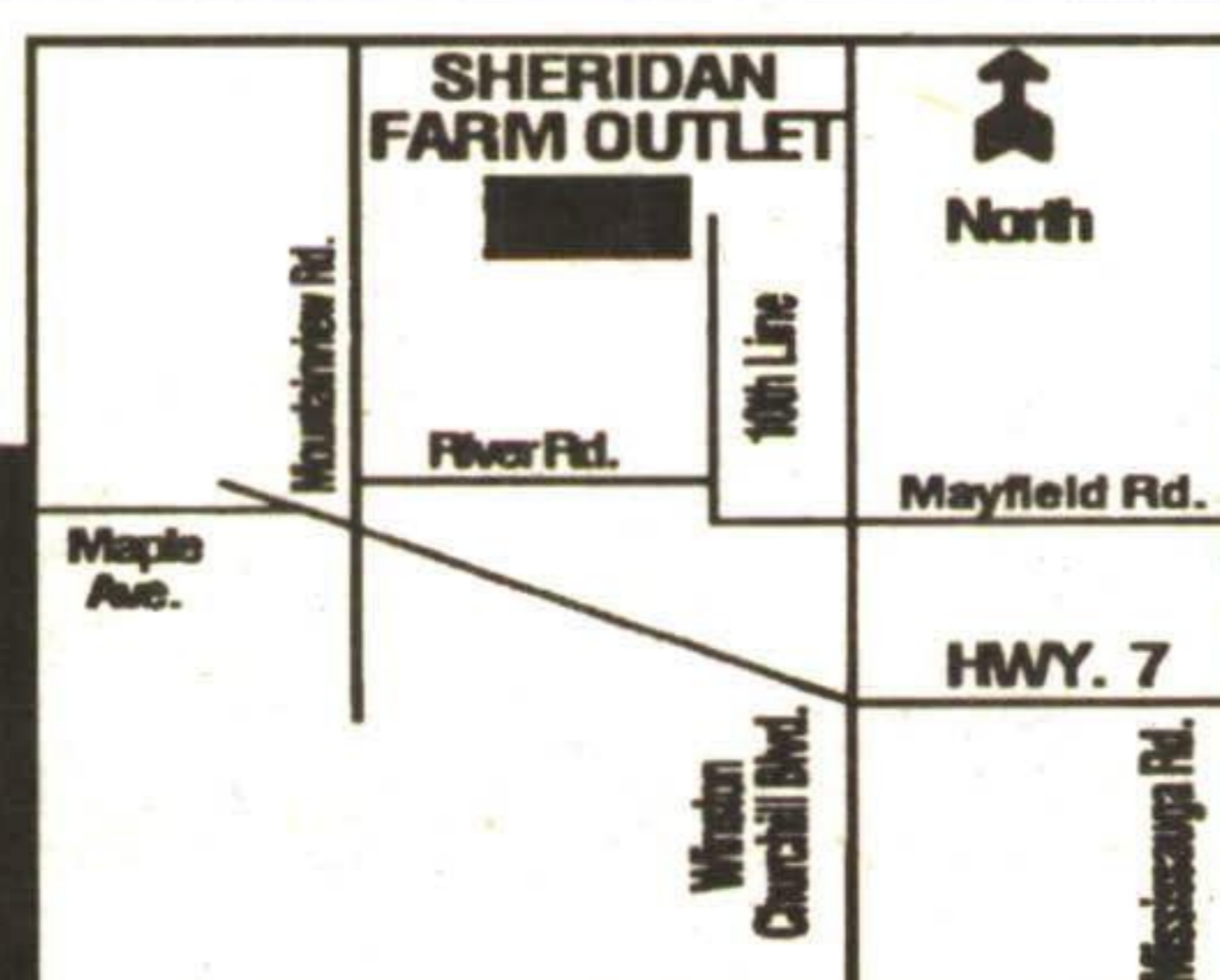
