

Learn how to be a budget traveller

A Terra Cotta couple will be giving a presentation on their travels in Thailand and Indonesia at the John Elliott Theatre on Thursday, Nov. 10 at 7:30 p.m.

Agnes and David Olive have been traveling for 15 years. They lived in Pakistan for three years and found it was an ideal spot to visit other countries in Asia. The Olives travel on a budget and enjoy getting off the beaten path.

Agnes operates The Forge Gallery, which she closes during the winter and David retired from his college teaching position last December. This allowed them to visit Indonesia between January

and April this year.

"We like to go to villages, to see customs and the crafts of local people. We won't buy something from shops if we can find the person who made it," Agnes said.

David has always enjoyed taking photographs and has put together a multi-projector audio visual presentation. They spent \$30 U.S. a day in Indonesia for both of them and \$40 a day in Thailand, excluding airfare.

"We went there because it's not too expensive, it's safe and easy to get around on a bus," Agnes said. As they travel, they meet other budget travelers and exchange information about places to visit and how to get there.

Not only do they have slides from their recent stay, but also

from a previous visit to Bali 15 years before. Over the years they have been throughout Asia, Central America and South America. This winter they plan to go to Mexico and are considering retiring there, providing it doesn't become more costly.

Agnes said they have never considered becoming snowbirds and vacationing in Florida during the winter as many people do.

They think their presentation will attract both armchair travelers and those who want to learn the logistics of budget travel.

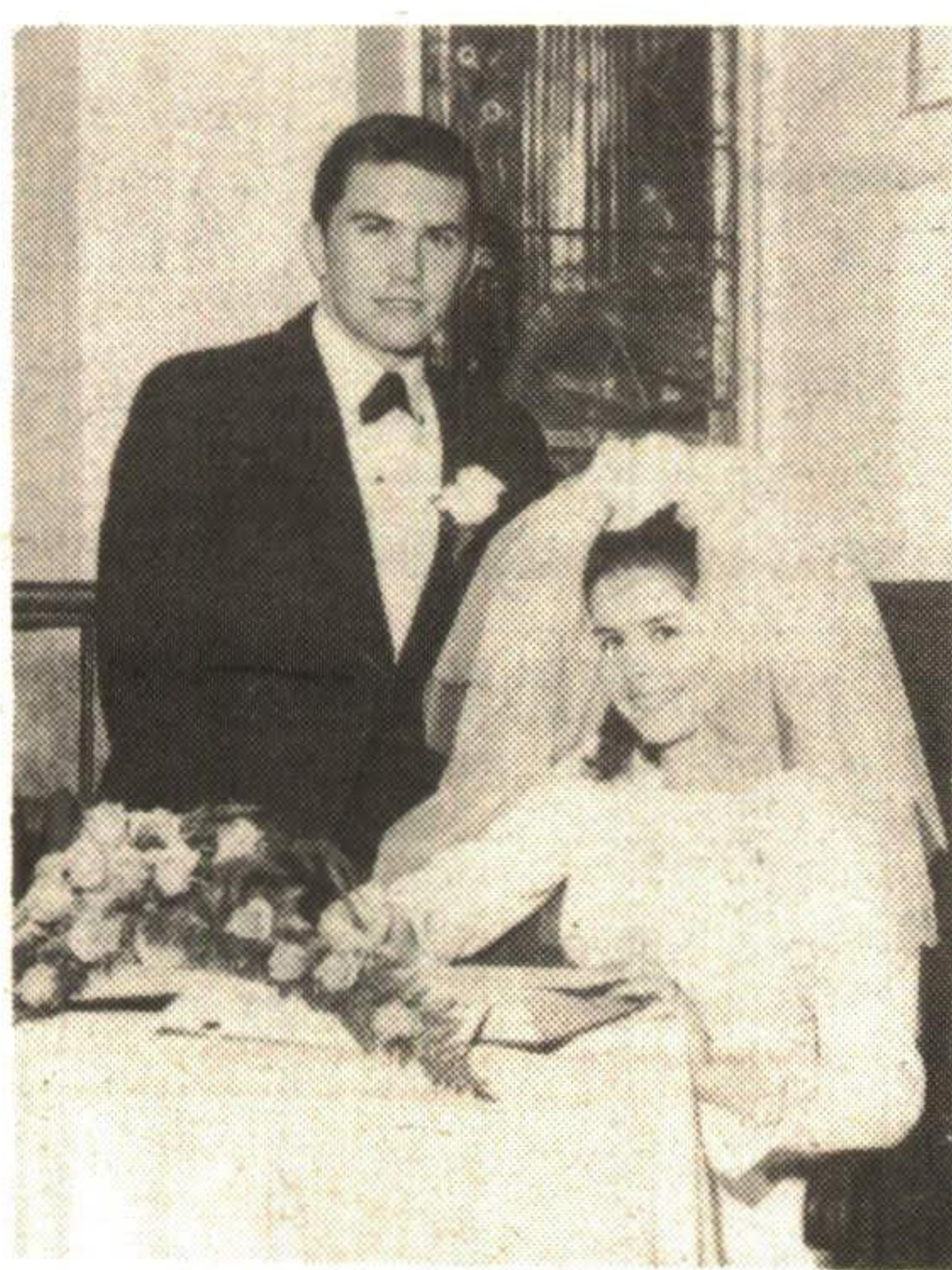
