

## Canada Remembers

### Choirs entertain veterans at special concert

Every November the world stops for a moment to remember and acknowledge the contribution veterans have made to world peace today.

And in the spirit of thanking them for their efforts and sacrifices, Georgetown Choral Society has organized a concert to honor their efforts.

A joint venture between the Choral Society and the Canada Remembers committee, a concert has been organized by a Remembrance Committee com-

prised of Rev. Peter Barrow, Tom Schenk, Dale Wood and Lois Fraser, to coincide with the 50th anniversary of the D-Day operations and the liberation of Europe.

"We wanted to honor our veterans here at home," says Tom Schenk

"Because there has been so much attention in Europe. This is an exciting year, with lots happening, but it is all overseas. We asked ourselves what we could do locally."

Billed as a Celebration of Remembrance, the concert will take place Sunday, November 6, at Knox Presbyterian Church,

in Georgetown, and will feature numerous vocal selections by the Choral Society and the Georgetown Children and Youth Choir. In addition, veterans and others will read excerpts

from prose and poetry.

"We wanted to schedule the concert so veterans could attend

Remembrance Day services during the day, then come out to the concert that evening," says Schenk, "That way, they can enjoy the entire day, and not miss a service."

Following the concert, a reception with coffee and desserts will be held in the church hall, allowing veterans time to visit and reminisce.

The Remembrance Concert is one of many activities Georgetown Choral Society is involved in as part of the 50th anniversary of the liberation of Europe.

In May of 1995, the group will travel to Holland to perform a number of concerts at several venues.

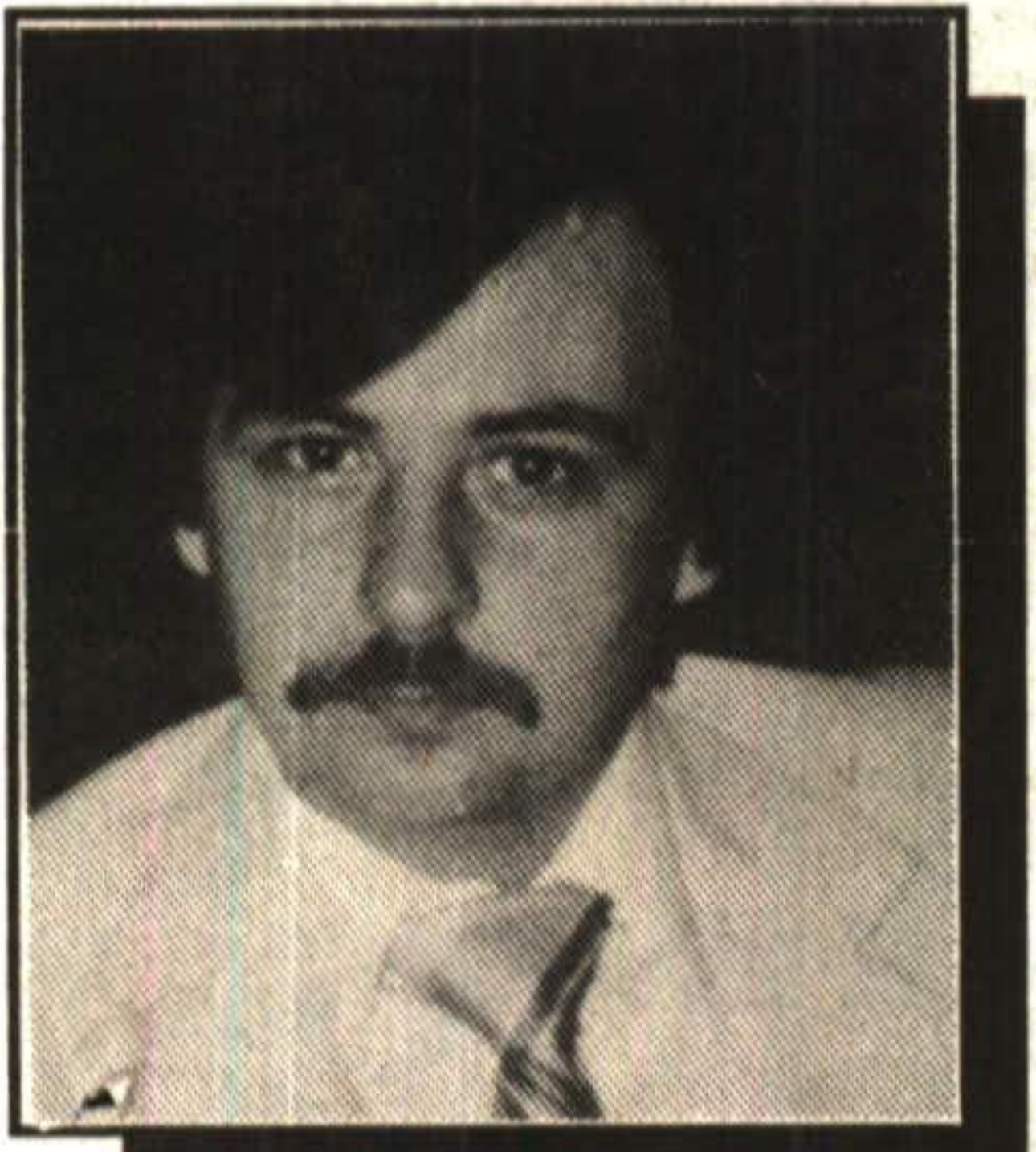
### Author visits
