Spielvogel said both float participants and financial donations are required.

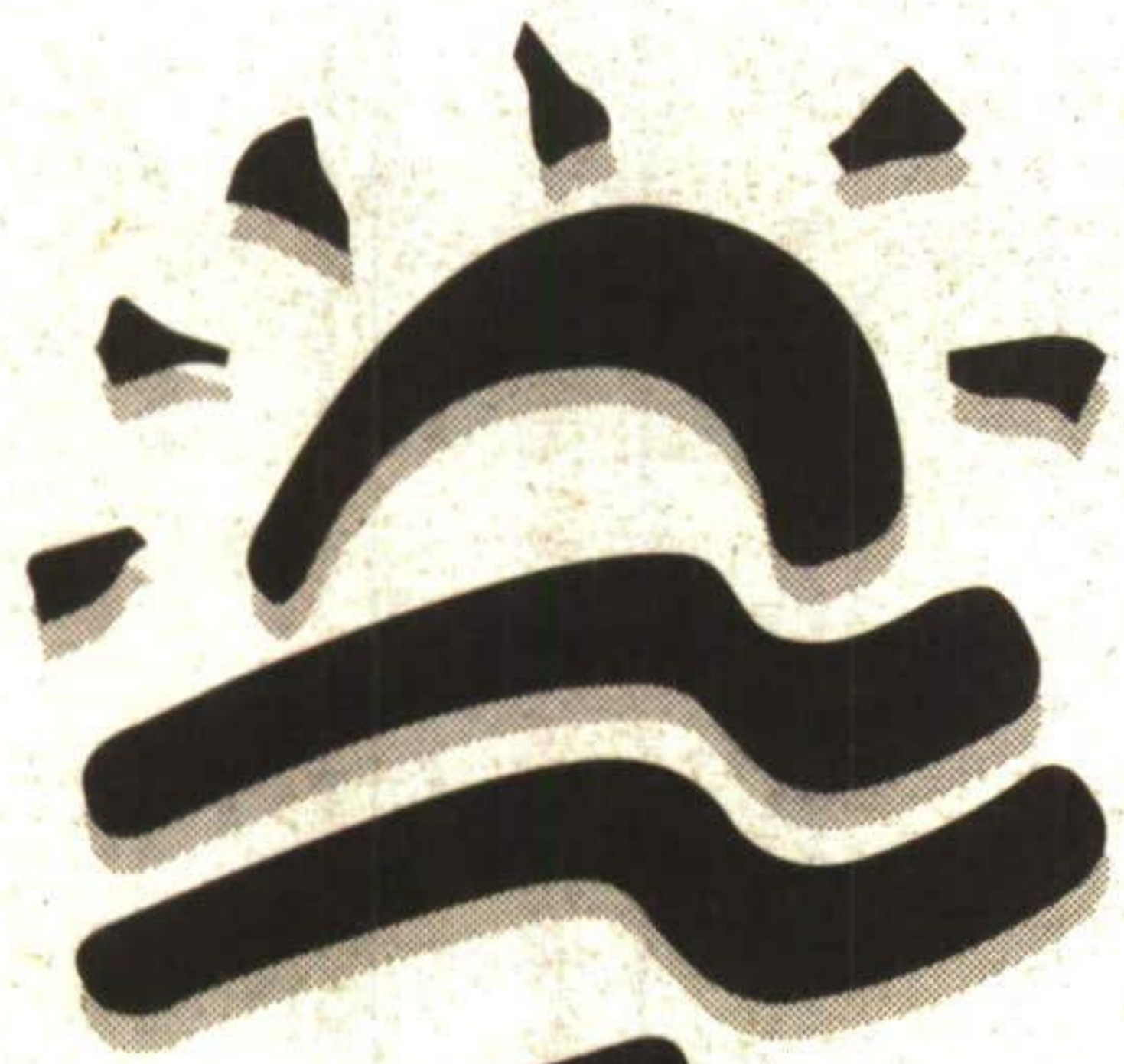
Cash prizes will be awarded for the floats; first overall prize will be \$100, first school prize will be

The parade will start from McKenzie-Smith Middle School on Acton Blvd.

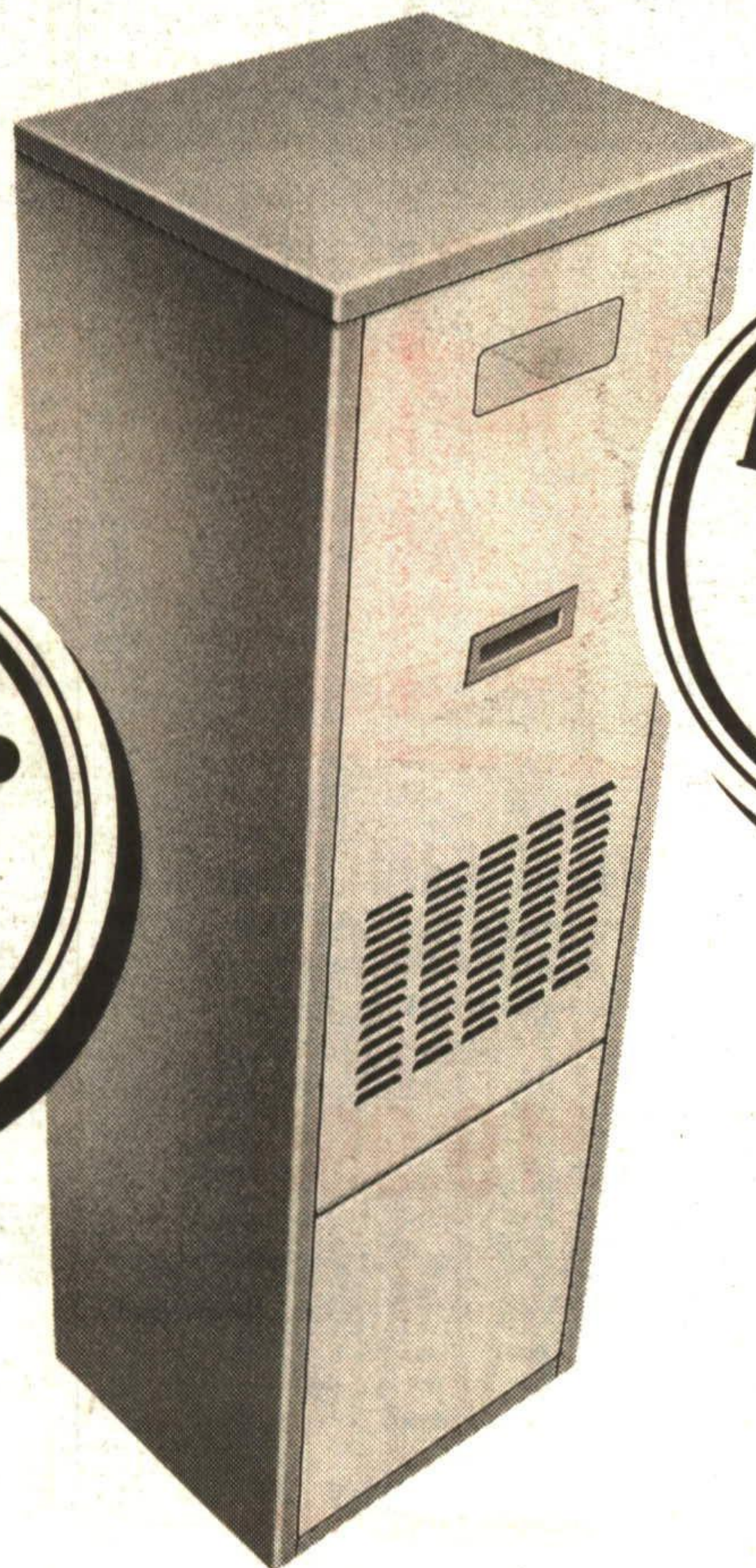
