Smart Alick is rising star on local rock 'n' roll scene

Rock 'n' roll is alive and well in Georgetown thanks to a young band who still plays the harder brand of

Their name is Smart Alick and they've been playing for five years now, on and off, at fairs, competitions and small gigs around town. At a recent Battle of the Bands, Smart Alick won five hours of recording time at Escarpment Studio and Sound. Band members are bassist, Michael Lee Stoker; drummer, Road Kill (Doug Staddon); lead guitarist, Lee Martin; rhythm, Todd Robinson and Phill Landriault.

Playing only cover (non-originals) songs at first, the band began to write their own material. With all five band members contributing to the writing of their new songs, an album is in the works and should be released in January or early February.

"It'll be a whole new wave of music," said Lee Martin, lead guitarist.

"It has everything from heavy metal to jazz."

Though this new wave of music has no name, the band hesitates to call it Alternative music because is not quite the same thing — it is different from everything else.

The band had originally planned on going on tour last summer but experienced booking problems; instead they played six or seven small gigs around town. In spite of losing the tour the band is raising funds to complete the album and




