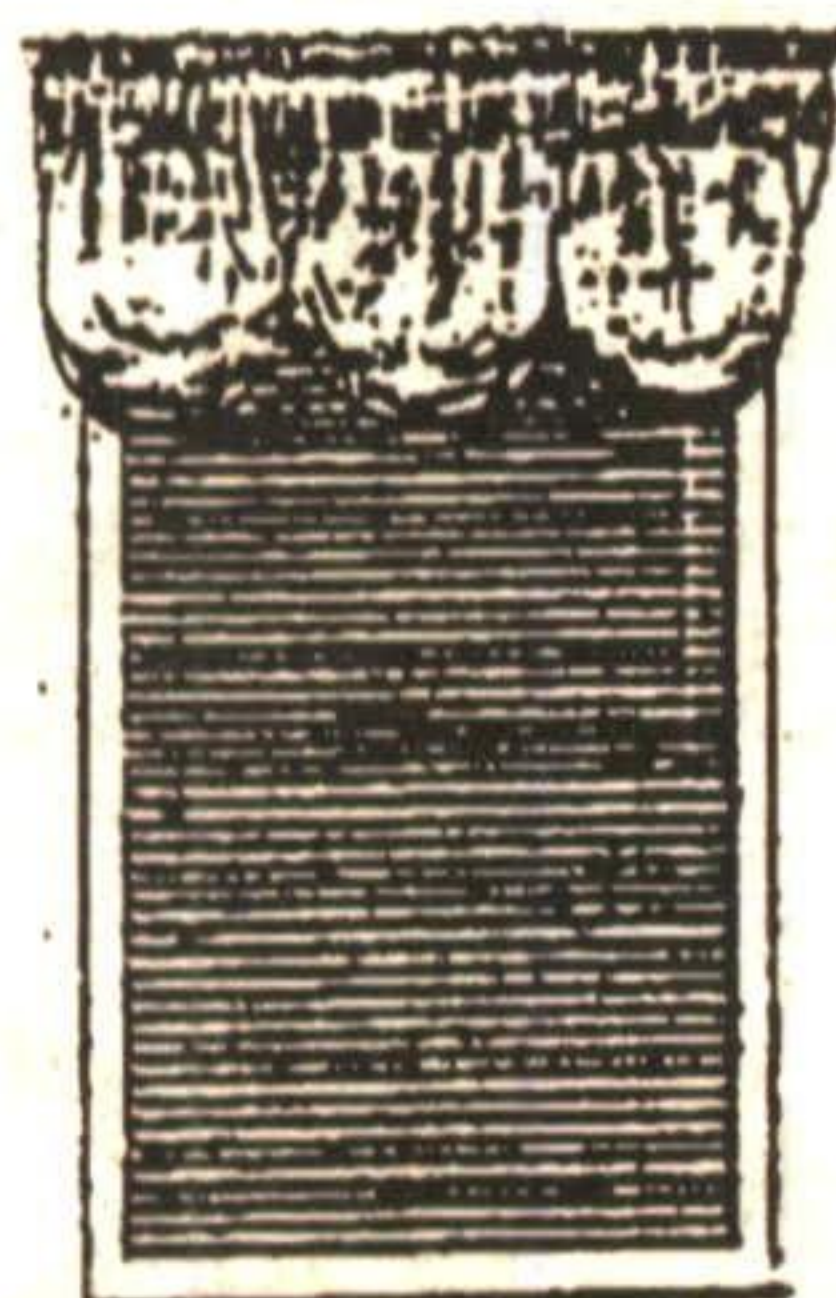

Our new mayor will receive a 1994 salary of \$61,101 — \$39,322 for town council responsibilities, \$18,705 for regional responsibilities and \$3,074 for participation on the hydro commission. Regional councillors will make \$30,316 — \$11,611 for the town and \$18,705 for the region. Town councillors will receive \$11,611. Public school board trustees will be paid \$12,900 and separate school board trustees will receive \$12,483. Halton Hills hydro commissioners will be paid \$3,074, the chairperson receives an additional \$485 per year.

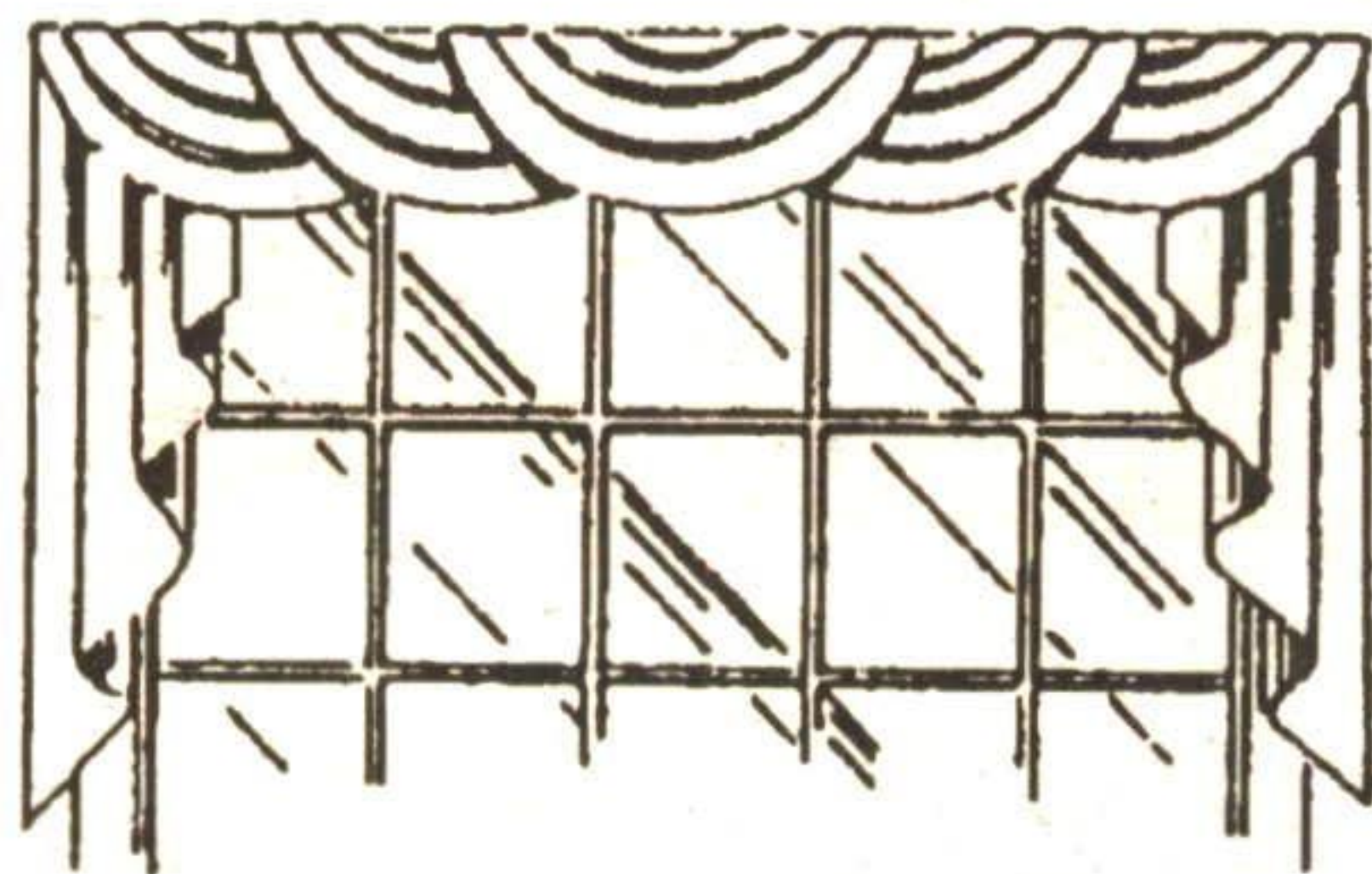

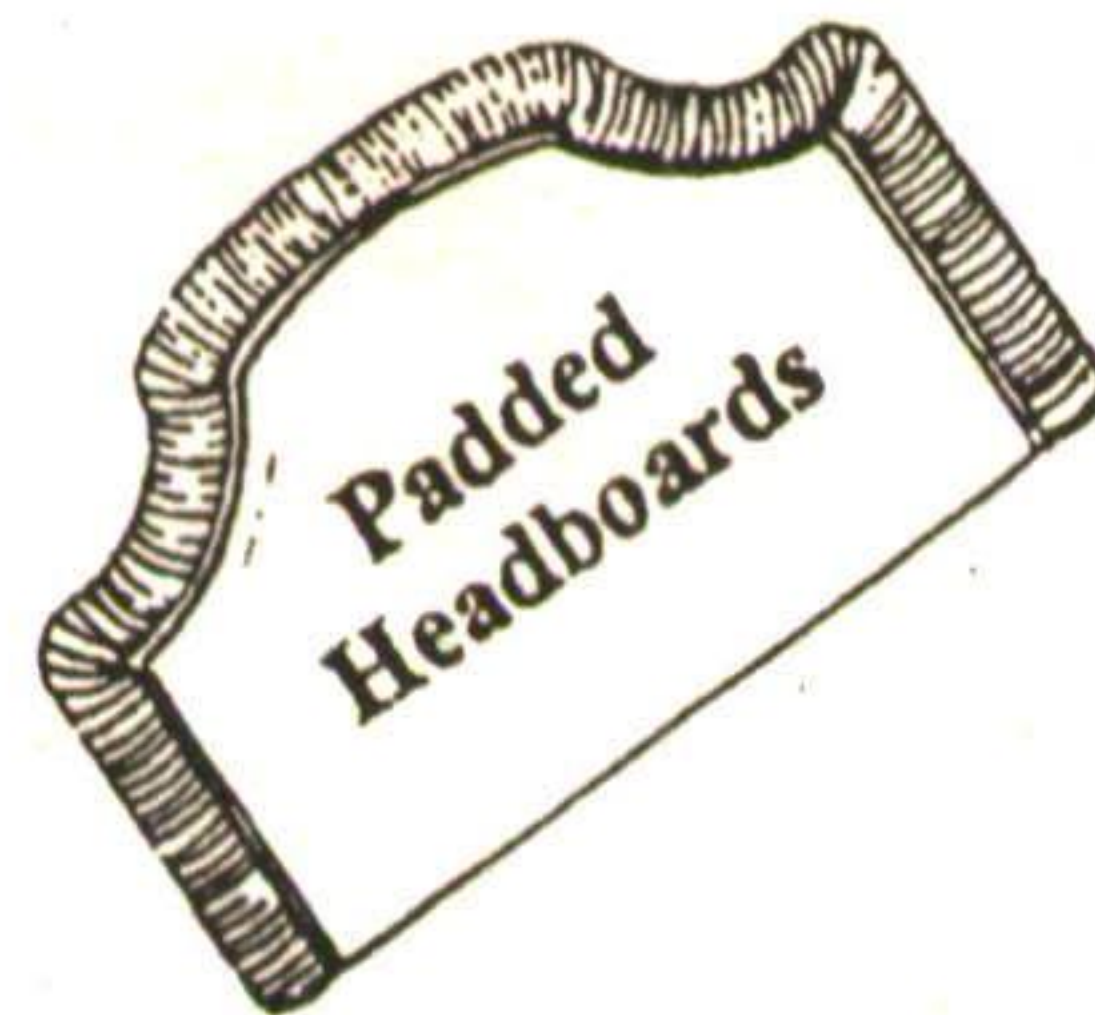
