### REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Registrations for Winter swimming and community programs will be accepted at the Civic Centre at any time by mail, drop-off or fax, or you can drop off registrations at the Acton Arena. However, they will not be processed until the **LOTTERY DEADLINE OF THUR., DEC. 1, 1994 AT 12:00 NOON**. Registrations received before the deadline are randomly selected by our computer. All registrations received after the deadline are processed on a first come, first serve basis. Confirmations will be mailed to all participants approximately ten days after the lottery deadline or 10 days following receipt for post-lottery registrations.

Due to the popularity of our recreational programs, registrations from Halton Hills will be processed first. Out-of-town registrations will be processed one week after the lottery deadline.
