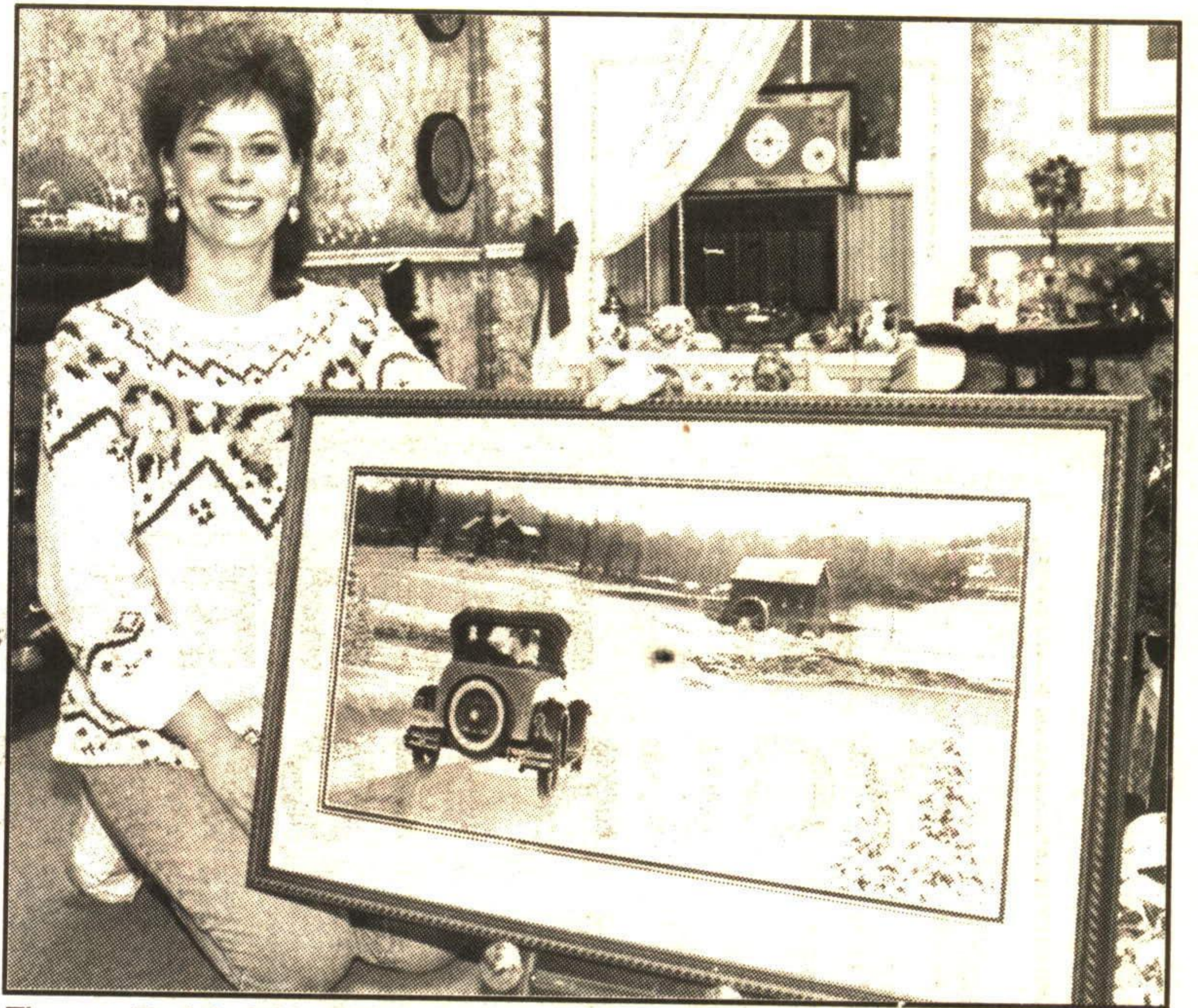

Silent auction for cancer

For the third year in a row, Pictures and Presents in Georgetown will be holding a silent art auction to benefit the Canadian Cancer Society.

Owner Theresa Rodobolski is offering 50 pieces of framed art and a number of unframed prints which will be displayed in the store, posted with a bid sheet and a reserve bid.

Starting November 29, anyone dropping by the 124 Main St. S. gallery can place a bid on the list, and bidders will be able to upgrade their bids until bidding closes Sunday, December 4, at 4 p.m. at a reception at the gallery. At that time, the top bid on each piece claims the artwork.

The reserve bid covers Rodobolski's cost of the art and the framing, and any money raised above that reserve is donated to the Georgetown unit of the Canadian Cancer Society. And the bidder only pays tax on the reserve.

The balance is viewed as a dona-

tion to the Cancer Society, so the bidder receives an income tax receipt for the sum of money above the reserve bid.

"I was really pleased to have a number of works donated to the auction by local artists this year," says Rodobolski. "Prints by Robert Bateman, Laura Berry, Shirley Deaville and James Lumbers have been donated. And since the reserve bid on the donated prints will only reflect the cost of the framing, the Cancer Society will receive a greater donation from those pieces."

In addition to the prints, some of the frames were donated as well, so the Cancer Society stands to receive more donations than ever.

Over the years, the silent auction has been a great success, raising more than \$6,000 for the Cancer Society over the two previous years.

"I've had a pretty good response from the past two auctions," says Rodobolski, "And I hope this year's no exception."
