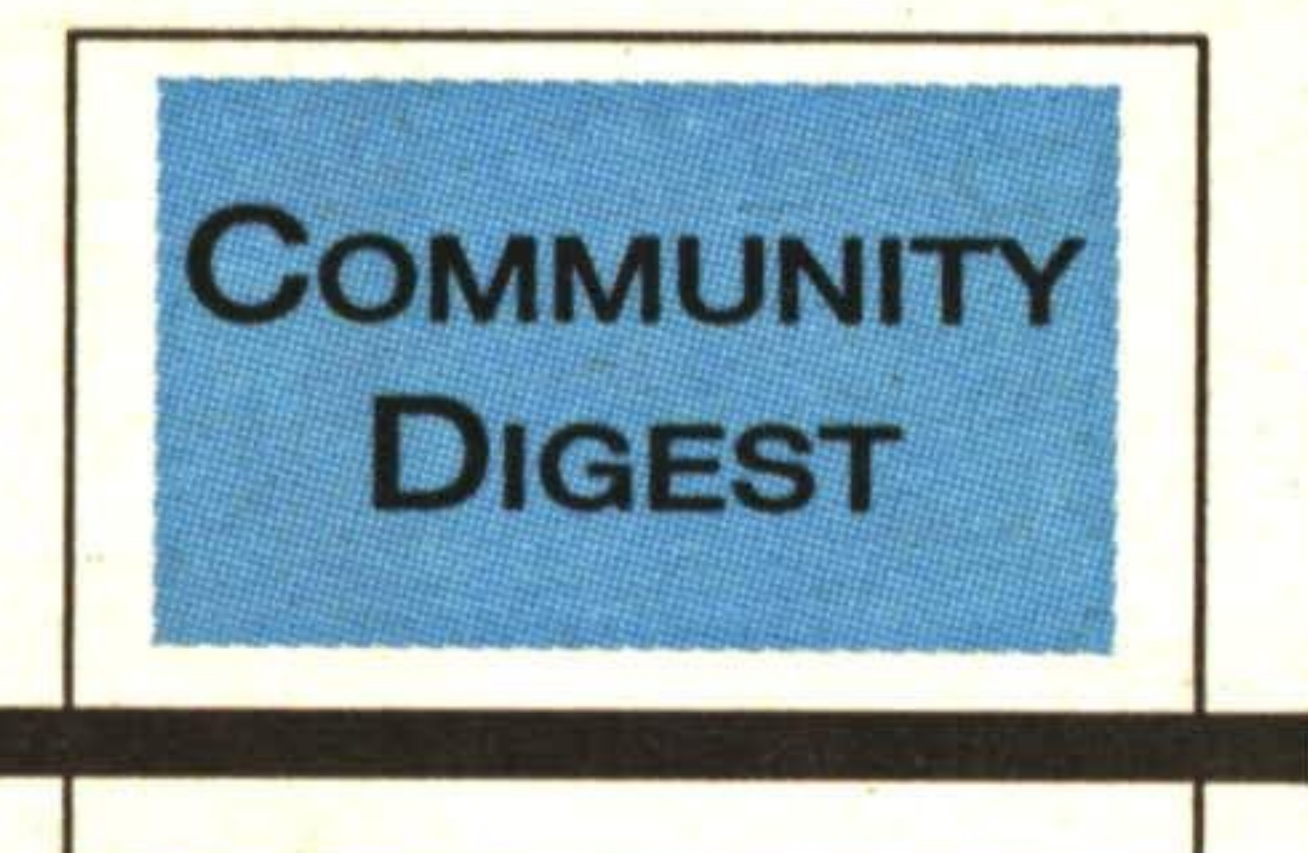


Licence revoked

The board also ordered the restaurant's licence holder, Emmanuel Protopapas, ensure all management and staff



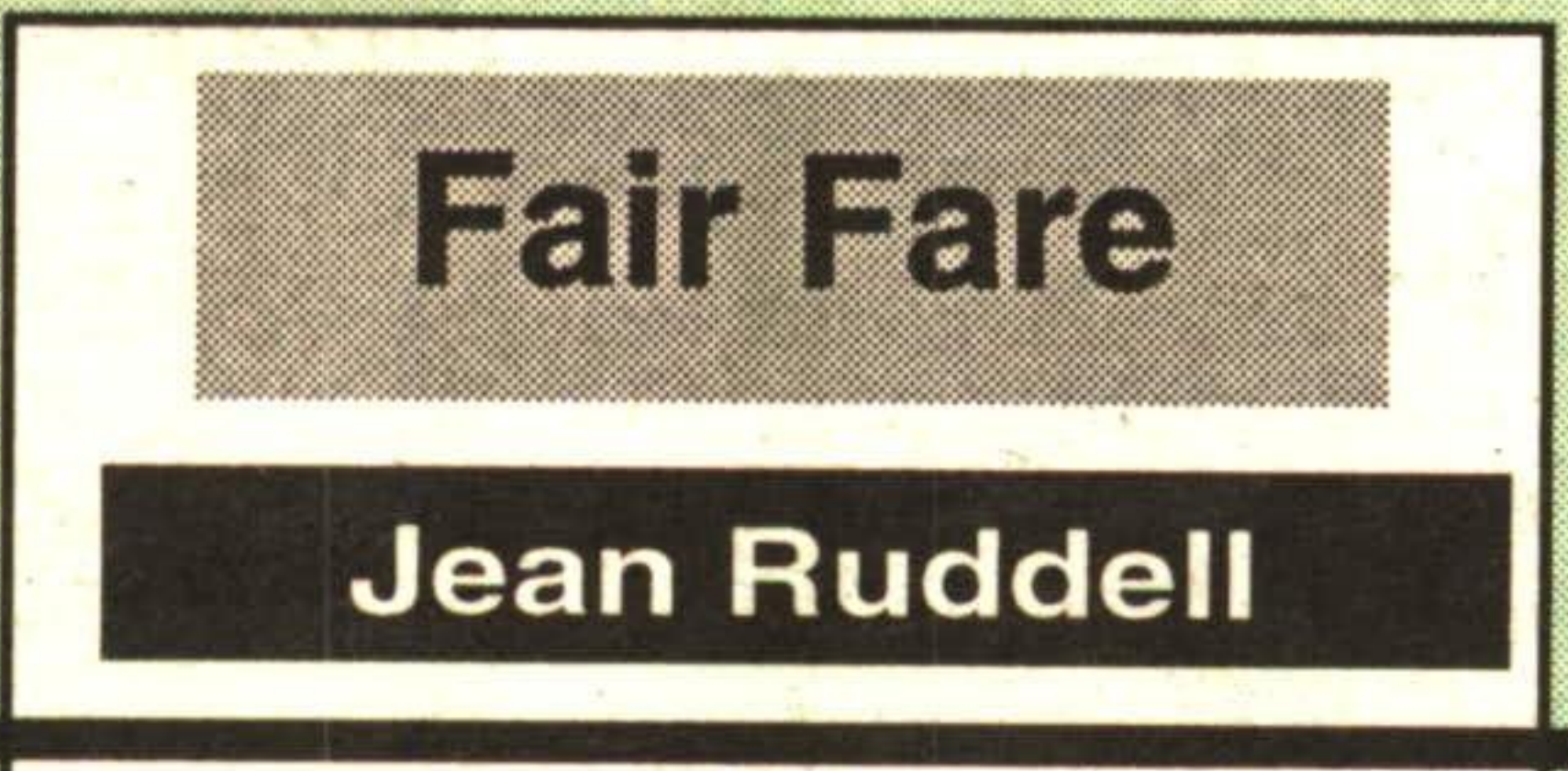
involved in the sale and service of alcohol complete the Smart Serve program offered by the Hospitality Industry Training Organization of Ontario.

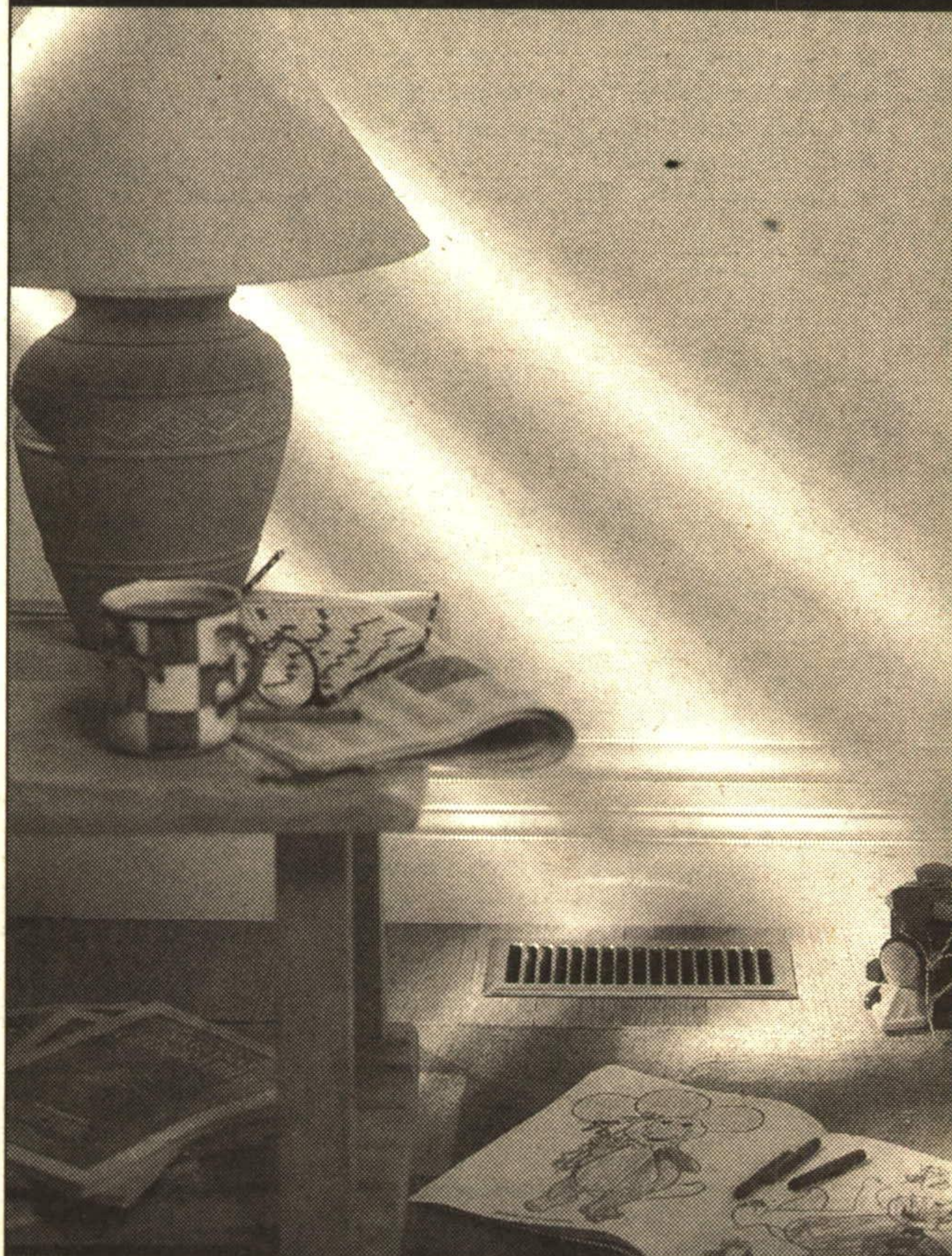
