Art groups join for anniversary show at the Gallery, Aug. 28 to Sept. 23

This year's annual Palette and Pencil art show will feature much more than canvas masterpieces.

The group will be celebrating its 30th anniversary next month and have invited the Credit Valley Artisans, who collectively turn 20-years-old in September, to take part in the annual show.

The event—which will be held at the Halton Hills Cultural Centre—starts this Wednesday, August 28 and runs through until Monday, September 23.

"We have between 15 and 20 artists confirmed for the

show. A special 'meet the artists' reception will be held on Wednesday, Sept. 4, from 7 to 9 p.m. Past members are more than welcome to attend," said Beatrice Dumbreck, president of Palette and Pencil. "We're hoping this year's show will be the best yet."

Highlighting the show will be work from a number of popular local painters including Georgetown's Laura Kingsbury, who specializes in area wildlife portraits. One of her works was commissioned by the Canadian government and presented to Russian President Boris Yeltsin.

Fellow Georgetown painters Una O'Callaghan and Esme Nicholson will also have their work on display. O'Callaghan uses oils and

acrylics to capture still-life and landscape portraits while Nicholson brings to life old buildings around town through the use of watercolor.

Potters, weavers, sculpturers and stain-glass artists from the Credit Valley Artisans will all have pieces on display. Helen McLaughlin and Elsie Staal-Neilson are among group members taking part in the show.

"All of our artists are from Halton Hills. With the addition of the Credit Valley Artisans, this year's show should be better than ever," added Dumbreck.

The Palette and Pencil/Credit Valley Artisans show will be open Tuesdays, Wednesday and Thursdays from 10:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. and Fridays and Saturdays from 10:30 a.m. to 5 p.m.

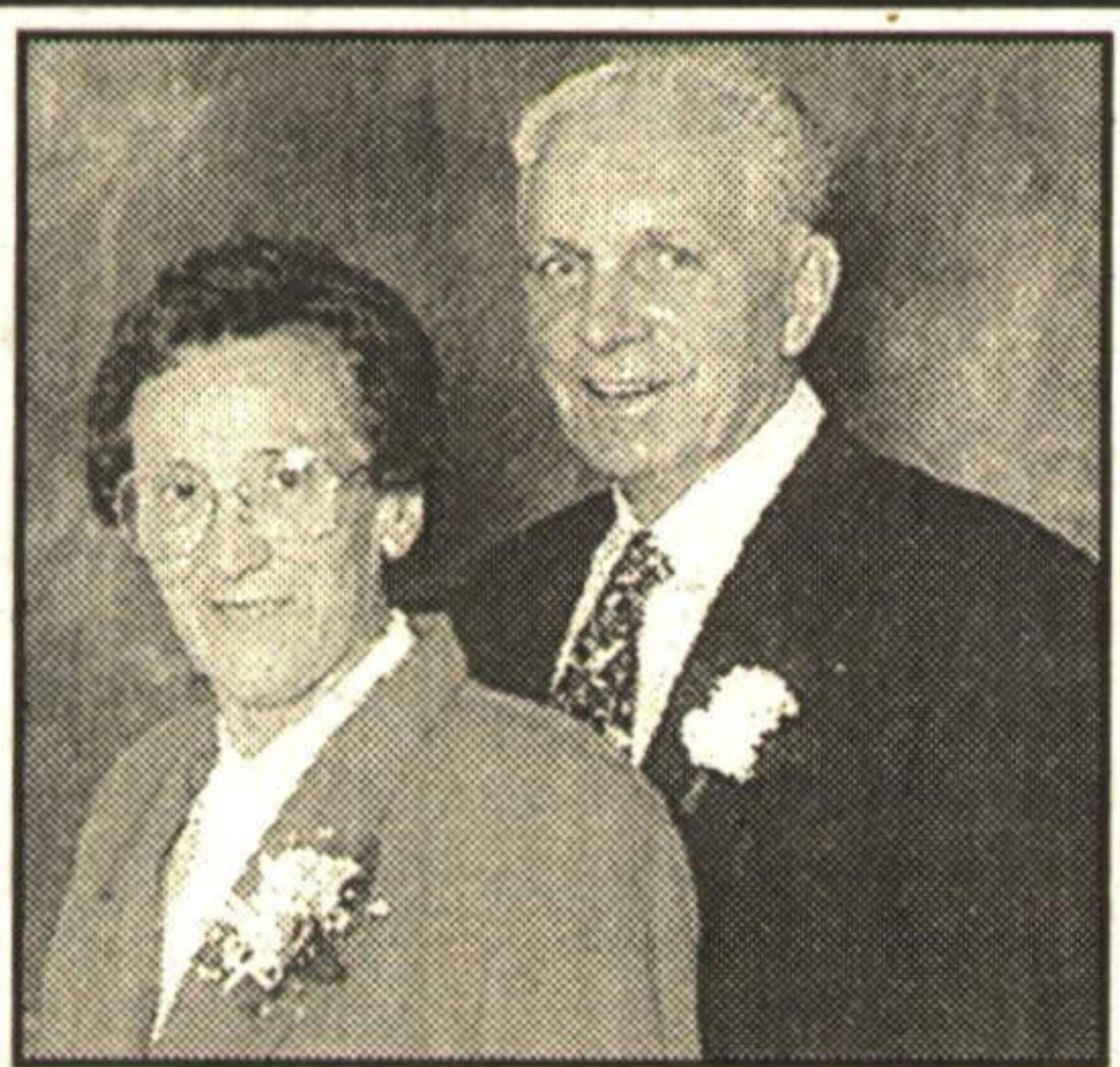
