COLLECTION INFORMATION

Yard Waste (except brush) must be placed in clear plastic bags or open containers (no garbage cans).

- This will distinguish it from garbage and ensure no contamination.
- Yard Waste collected is composted into an excellent soil conditioner. This saves valuable landfill space and reduces landfill leachate contamination.

Brush must be <u>bundled and tied</u>, not bagged, in lengths no longer than 4 feet and no wider than 2 feet, with no branches larger than 3 inches in diameter.

Tying in small bundles aids in collection.
