## Taxi Robbery

It is alleged: On Friday, October 2 just before 6 a.m., a Milton Taxi driver was robbed in the area of Derry Road and Bronte Street. The taxi driver was assaulted by the suspect before he was thrown from the cab. The suspect fled the area in the stolen taxi and the victim was treated for minor injuries.

Images of the suspect were obtained by police. Later that afternoon police located the stolen taxi in the City of Mississauga. On October 5, an arrest warrant was issued for Michael Zachary CODREN (32 years) of New Brunswick.

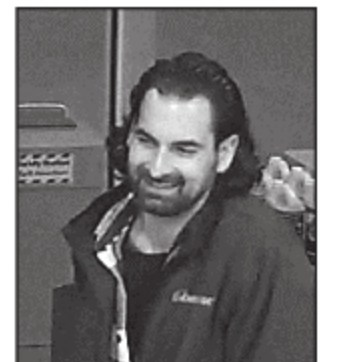
He is now wanted by the Halton Regional Police Service for:

Condren is described as: 5'11", 175 lbs, brown eyes, a black scruffy beard and
