

Halton Police investigating armed robbery

The Halton Regional Police Service is investigating an armed robbery at a financial institution and is seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect.

On Friday, December 18

at approximately 5 p.m., a lone masked suspect entered the Bank of Montreal branch located at 21 Mill Street East in Acton. Once inside the suspect banished a firearm and a demand was made for money.

A quantity of cash was turned over to the suspect before fleeing the scene on foot in an unknown direction. During the course of the incident two bank tellers were assaulted by the suspect, and sustained

minor injuries.

The suspect is described as: Male, black, early 20's, approximately 5'6" - 5'8", thin build, wearing a black balaclava, grey hoodie sweater, black pants,
