

OPP REPORT

Impaired by drug

On December 16 at approximately 11:50 p.m., an officer with the Wellington County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) Traffic Management Unit (TMU) responded to a call at Woodfield Crescent, Guelph-Eramosa Township about a male sitting in his car with the vehicle running. Police spoke with a male and he appeared to be impaired by a drug. He was arrested and during the search, Police located items utilized for illegal drug use. Police also learned the he was not following conditions imposed on him by a Police Service from outstanding criminal charges. He was brought to a local OPP Operations Centre for testing.

The driver's licence has been suspended for 90 days and the vehicle impounded for a period of seven days as per statute.

A 33-year-old of Guelph man has been charged with Care or Control While Impaired by a Drug and Fail to Comply with a Condition of an Undertaking Given by an Officer in Charge X 3 contrary to the Criminal Code of Canada. He is to appear in Guelph Criminal Court on January 26 to answer to the charges.

Homicide investigation Police Seeking the Assistance of the Public

Members of the Wellington County Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) responded to a report of a sudden death located east of the 10th Line off Wellington Road 124 shortly before 7 a.m. on December 17, Investigators discovered the body of a male victim at that location and cordoned off the area.

On December 19, a forensic post mortem was conducted in Toronto at the Office of the Chief Coroner and Forensic Pathology Service. The cause of death is evidence in the investigation and will not be released.


Members of the Wellington County Crime Unit, under the direction of Criminal Investigation Branch Detective Inspector Andy Raffay and Detective Staff Sergeant Rob Lake have exhausted efforts to locate next-of-kin. Police are asking anyone known to the victim to come forward.

The victim has been identified as 65-year-old Frederick John Hatch with no fixed address. He is described as male white approximately 167 cm (5'6") tall, heavier build, grey downward sloping moustache and grey over the collar length hair; he was wearing a dark coloured hoodie and blue ieans.

Police believe the victim travelled from eastern Ontario on Wednesday, December 16, 2015 arriving in the Erin area later that day or in the early morning hours of December 17, 2015.


