# FIRE REPORT

## Tuesday, April 28

At 7:14 a.m. Fire fighters responded to the report of smoke in the area on Main St N in Acton. The caller had advised that they could see black smoke from behind their home. Fire staff noted smoke coming from the rear of a building on Main Street North. They had just started a fire. They did call it in and they were burning within the limits of their permit. No concerns at this time.

At 3:28 p.m. Fire fighters responded to a public assist on Sprowl Street. The homeowner had drilled into the main water line coming into the house, causing the basement to flood. The break was before the water shut off. Halton Region was contacted to turn the water supply off to the house.

## Thursday, April 30

11:21 a.m. Fire fighters responded to an ambulance assist to gain entry into a house where they had received a distress call, on Churchill Road South in Acton. With Halton Regional Police on scene, fire staff gained access through the rear door

of the garage and then into the house from a door inside the garage.

## Friday, May 1

11:51 a.m. Fire fighters responded to a two-vehicle motor vehicle collision in the area of Highway 7 and Sixth Line. Vehicles were stabilized and patients were treated for their injuries and then transported to the hospital. The scene was then turned over to Halton Regional Police.

At 8:23 p.m. Fire fighters responded to a burn complaint on James Young Drive in Acton. On scene staff met with the homeowner who had a small contained fire in the backyard. The homeowner extinguished the fire and was made aware that a permit was required.

## Sunday, May 3, 2015

3:08 p.m. Fire fighters responded to a burn complaint on Regional Road 25, north of Five Side-road. On scene staff found the homeowner burning leaves in two piles in their driveway. Staff extinguished the fires and advised of the permit process.

A draft By-law, amending the Town of Halton Hills Property Standards By-law No. 2008-0137, a By-law to establish Standards for the maintenance and occupancy of Property will be presented to Town Council on May 25, 2015. It is proposed that the Property Standards By-law be amended to include maintenance requirements for Designated Heritage Properties in the Town of Halton Hills; amendments pertaining to the changes in the Ontario Building Code; and general housekeeping amendments.
