Drug Trafficker
In the early morning hours of May 8, members of the Halton Regional Police One District Strategic Support Team concluded a two week investigation into an alleged drug trafficker working in the Town of Milton.

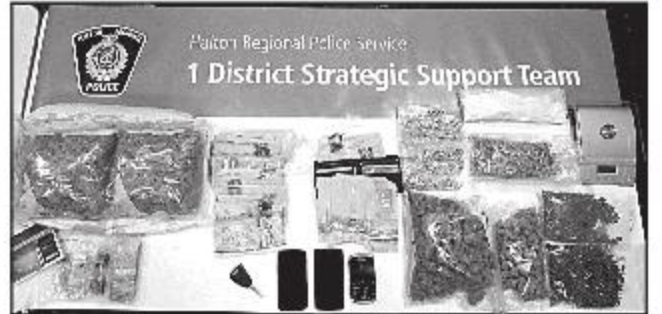
The investigation culminated with the execution of a Controlled Drugs and Substances Act search warrant at a residence in the Town of Milton.

During the execution of this warrant police seized the following items:

- 1.5 pounds of cannabis marihuana
 - 6.5 ounces MDMA
 - 2.5 ounces psilocybin
 - 550 tabs of ecstasy
 - 2.5 grams cocaine
 - 1.0 grams cannabis resin
 - Digital Scales
 - Multiple cellular telephones
 - \$15,000 Canadian Currency
- Accused:
A 28 year old of Milton

man has been charged with:

- Trafficking in a controlled substance (cannabis marihuana)
 - Possession for the purpose of trafficking (cannabis marihuana)
 - Possession for the purpose of trafficking (cocaine)
 - Possession for the purpose of trafficking (MDMA)
 - Possession for the purpose of trafficking (Psilocybin)
 - Possession of a controlled substance (cannabis resin)
