### ASK THE PROFESSIONAL

Q

**My mother is in a nursing home and the family member making health decisions for her under a power of attorney won't tell me anything about her health or care. Do they have to provide me with information?**

A

*Substitute Decisions Act (SDA)*  
The SDA provides that a person who holds a power of attorney for a person who is incapable must act in the best interests of the incapable person. This includes the duty to provide information to the incapable person's family members, unless the power of attorney specifically states otherwise. In your case, the family member making health decisions for your mother under a power of attorney has a duty to provide you with information about her health and care, unless the power of attorney specifically states otherwise. If the power of attorney does not specifically state otherwise, you have the right to be informed about your mother's health and care.
