## Stop living in the statistics. Physiotherapy can help

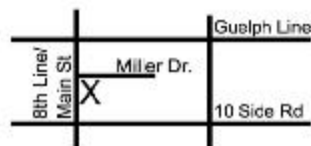

# Halton police cruiser, vehicle crash on Hwy. 407

Two people, including a Halton Regional Police officer, were sent to hospital following a collision between a police cruiser and a vehicle that police were attempting to stop last Sunday afternoon.

Shortly after 2 p.m., police were conducting an investigation into a possible stolen car when the suspect vehicle entered the west-bound Hwy. 407 lanes from Dundas St. in Burlington.

The officer attempted to stop the vehicle and as a result there was a collision between the police cruiser and the suspect's car. The collision caused both vehicles to lose control and crash. The lone occupant of the stolen vehicle was arrested after a brief foot chase.

The involved officer sustained minor injury as a result of the collision and was transported to an area hospital. The suspect was also seen at hospital and was released a short time later.

The OPP closed this portion of Hwy. 407 for a brief period as the collision was investigated. James Arthur Warner, 39, of no fixed address has been charged with the following:

- flight causing bodily harm



- dangerous driving causing bodily harm
- possession of stolen property over \$5,000
- possession of stolen property (licence plates) under \$5,000
- obstructing police
- identity fraud
- identity theft
- breach of probation (three counts)
- suspend drive (Highway Traffic Act)

Warner has been held in police custody pending a bail hearing.

Police continue to investigate this incident.
