

Arctic champion is speaker at Social Justice Series

The final event in the Inuit Outreach Halton Hills Winter/Spring Social Justice Series will be a presentation by Johnny Issaluk, a world champion in Arctic high kick and a medal winner at the Arctic Winter Games, the Inuit Winter Olympics.

The event will be held on Saturday, April 9 at St. Paul's Anglican Parish Hall, 16 Ad- amson St. in Norval. Doors open at 6 p.m. with a presentation at 7 p.m. Suggested entry donation of \$25 (tax receipts provided.)

This fundraiser will support the spring shipment of clothing, household and essential items to northern communities in Nunavik and Nunavut.

Issaluk has found his professional passion working as the Executive Director of Embrace Life Council, a non-profit organization that endeavours to serve Nunavummiut through suicide prevention, providing support and counseling to residential school survivors and delivering the engaging Inuusivut program teaching photography and filmography to youth.

As an athlete Issaluk has been practising, competing, performing, coaching and

teaching Inuit Games for more than 20 years. His athletic career has yielded more than 200 medal finishes in regional and national competitions and has culminated in his status as one of the most successful Inuit Games athletes of his generation.

The Inuit Outreach Project has been collecting and sending clothing, household and essential items to the north since 2010. It is a vibrant and growing organization whose foundational support comes from three small Anglican churches with big hearts in the Halton Hills region - St Paul's, Norval; St John's, Stewarttown and St. Stephen's, Hornby.

The request for assistance has been answered in the form of nearly 15 tons over the shipments done twice a year.
