

Heavy Truck - Half Load Restrictions are in effect

Half Load Restrictions are in effect for heavy trucks until May 15, 2016

In Caledon, heavy trucks are permitted on Regional roads, such as Airport Road. On Town roads, however, heavy trucks are restricted with certain exceptions, including "Local Deliveries"

(via the shortest route from the closest available truck route). Refer to the Town Traffic By-law at caledon.ca/by-laws for more information.

Half-load Season (March 15 - May 15)

To protect Town roads during the spring thaw, there is an annual half-load season from March 15 to May 15. During this period vehicles are restricted to a maximum of 5 tonnes per axle. The dates may be adjusted depending on weather.
