

Halton Hills Yard Waste Collection Begins April 4



Collection Areas A and B only

From **April 4 to December 9, 2016** your yard waste is collected **once every other week** on Tuesdays.

Place your yard waste at the curb by 7 a.m. the morning of your collection day, but no sooner than 5 p.m. the evening before.

- Tie and bundle brush no larger than 2 m x 1 m (6 ft x 3 ft) wide, with branches a maximum of 7.5 cm in diameter
- No rocks or sharp objects
- Use paper yard waste bags or reusable, rigid container (no lid) with a yard waste label

- Yard waste can also be dropped off at the Halton Waste Management Site (5400 Regional Road 25, Milton, Monday to Saturday, 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.). User fees apply visit halton.ca/HWMS

If you use private trash services for your yard waste or use a private waste disposal service, you are responsible for your own disposal.

Acceptable yard waste

- ✓ Leaves and weeds
- ✓ Stems and twigs (less than 2 m)
- ✓ Grass clippings

Unacceptable yard waste

- ✗ Grass clippings (over 7.5 cm in diameter)
- ✗ Stumps and trunks
- ✗ Shingles, asphalt, roofing
- ✗ Paint, oil, antifreeze, car parts
- ✗ Fertilizer, pesticides, herbicides
